additional interest is the fact that of all the classifications of Donors, including businessmen and others, teachers are, percentage-wise, the most numerous.

- e. Endowments. Up to the present time the financing of The Foundation's work has been entirely by annual, voluntary donations. Bequest forms will, however, be sent on request.

### REVENUE REQUIREMENTS

The cost for publications per person per year, just for printing and postage, is about \$5.00. This allows nothing for other costs. If The Foundation's primary distribution were to reach 100 persons per county, some 300,000 in all, the requirement would be \$1,500,000 annually. This is the objective in mind. The financial goal is about one-fourth realized.

### IS THE FOUNDATION TAX EXEMPT?

Donations to The Foundation are deductible for income tax purposes to the extent provided by law.

### WHEN WAS FOUNDATION STARTED?

The Foundation is the result of ideas many years in the making, but the legal date of its

beginning was March 23, 1946. The balance of 1946, however, was used primarily in acquiring headquarters, staff, and initial financing. It might be said, therefore, that it had its operational beginning in 1947.

### WHERE IS FOUNDATION LOCATED?

At Irvington-on-Hudson, New York, 21 miles north of Times Square. The headquarters is a rambling old house that has been fitted into a workshop.

### ARE TRUSTEES, AFFILIATES OR DONORS IMPLICATED IN VIEWS EXPRESSED?

Never. Each study is the work of some individual person. It is his, and is represented as being his. Other members of the staff, Trustees, Affiliates and Donors are not implicated. Concurrence of others is never as much as suggested.

The Foundation employs the individualistic, as contrasted with the committee, approach. Each writer has the advantage of the knowledge, experience and suggestions of others, which he accepts or rejects in strict accordance with his own best judgment. Ideas, logic and facts are left to stand on their own. The reader is the judge.
