

money to the IWA; IWA work is important and growth is needed; the proposal can be flexible; sections should pay what they can.

Steve: I propose that we accept an increase in IWA dues, but pay the old rate until the dues increase has formally passed; thus, we wouldn't pay the new, full rate until next year.

Mitch: What if the IWA approves the proposal in the next couple months?

Steve: We'll hold our stance.

Status of motion : passed, with two opposed.

2. Relations with the IWA and Other Groups.

Mike: There is internal confusion in the IWW regarding affiliation with the IWA.

Steve: We should formally empower Angie and Ginger to represent WSA if they go to the IWW Convention.

Mitch: Interamerican Congress will be held at the end of October/beginning of November; we must go, they won't take no for an answer; the IWA is willing to pay 50% of the cost; we need someone with excellent Spanish.

Steve: We should agree to go, at least in principle; I nominate Vince.

Ginger: We need to determine the funding situation; we don't want to committ and then not have funds.

Steve: As Treasurer, I'll solicit funds; I make a motion that we send a delegate, with Vince and Ed as candidates, and that special solicitations be made with dues reminders in July to cover costs.

Status of motion : passed, unanimously.
