THE ACS CURRICULUM

BIBLE—This is a high quality, fundamental, exciting program that provides a total view of the King James Version during the school years, first through high school.

ENGLISH—This is a back-to-basics program with a heavy emphasis on learning the parts of speech, diagraming, research papers, essays, and composition.

MATH—This solid program begins with the knowledge that God created everything and because of this, order has resulted. It teaches that students can expect exactness, preciseness and completeness in mathematics just as they can expect it in God's creation. We start with the basic facts and proceed to the more complicated and abstract concepts in the upper grades.

SCIENCE—This refreshing, new program gives a student a basic understanding of science from the Christian viewpoint as presented in the Word of God. A proper study of these basic concepts helps familiarize a student with a basic body of knowledge necessary to being an informed Christian in a world of technology.

HISTORY—No more social studies but old fashioned history and geography. (Social Studies was a product of the humanists in the late 1930's.) The root of the word "history" means "knowing." It actually is a record of the affairs of mankind down through the ages of time. History provides us with examples of success and

failure, of victories and defeats, and of great men with courage and character and inhumane tyrants with cowardice and cruelty. History is a record which reveals the sovereignty of God in the affairs of man. It is a record of the human knowledge of the development in time of the divine plan of the universe. This concept recognizes that the universe was planned, created, sustained, and ordered by an infinite God. This, we try to impress upon each student who studies one of our history courses.

LITERATURE—ACS has developed a complete literature series for Christian Schools. Our students are exposed to the greatest literature in the past three hundred years starting with the McGuffey reader in kindergarten on through the sixth grade. The McGuffey recalls an America where honesty, hard work, kindness, patience, obedience to authority, fairness, gentleness, and frugality were traits to be admired. This, we emphasize in our literature program. The upper grades study Bunyan's *Pilgrim's Progress*, *Holy War*, and other classics of the last three hundred years.

PENMANSHIP—This is our biggest seller since the same book is used for all students second through the ninth grades. We have discovered that almost all students need this course since they did not learn the basics of penmanship in the early years. Even Penmanship is taught from a Christian perspective!

BASIC SKILLS CLASS

Teachers have had fantastic success with our Right Start Program for Pre-K and Kindergarten children. Even teachers without any experience have found this strong phonics approach to reading a fantastic tool in teaching children to read in about three months. A day to day teacher's manual along with a cassette tape provides everything a teacher needs to have children reading by January 1, of the school year. Each student receives a phonics reader and about 900 forms (in three pads) that will provide a rich foundation in math, writing, and reading. When the student has learned to read, he then goes into the McGuffey Primer and from there into the ACS Art-Literature series.

PRE-K CLASS

The Right Start Pre-K program parallels the Kindergarten program. It also has a teacher's manual and a pad of forms that introduces the student to colors, shapes, sizes, numbers, the alphabet, etc. It is not as demanding as the Kindergarten program, but very effective in preparing students for the following year.

SIMPLE APPROACH

ACS has been written to be used in an individualized or a traditional classroom although most schools use it with the individualized mode. Usually, one large book contains work for an entire year although two books are needed for a couple of courses. Each book has 36 chapters, one for each week of the school year. This simple approach eliminates the confusing, time-consuming chore of goal setting and checking. One west coast pastor said of ACS: "It is like a breath of fresh air."
