

share of votes in the parliamentary elections of well under 10%. The FREEDOM PARTY, formerly known as the LEAGUE OF INDEPENDENTS, was founded by Anton Reinthaller a Nazi dating back to 1923 and a minister in the Austrian quisling regime during World War II, Peppered with former SS men and Nazi Party members this party's influence on the Austrian political situation has been nominal. 'Neue Front' is the official organ of the FREEDOM PARTY.

A student organization RING FREIHEITLICHER STUDENTEN(RFS) has recently increased its vote share to 35% in the student elections. Perhaps one of the main reasons for the strength of this neo-Nazi student union can be attributed to neo-Nazi teachers and professors; in fact, 90% of the teachers in the provinces were at one time Nazi Party members. The most well known of these neo-Nazi professors is Taras Borodajkewycz, for 10 years he preached anti-Semitism, Racism, and pro-Nazism to students. It was only after massive protests against him that the matter came to a head, finally a court verdict forced him into retirement. A good portion of the terrorist attacks in the South Tyrol have been committed by members of this Rightist student union.

Two other organizations that carry neo-Nazi undertones are OSTERREICHISCHER TURNENBUND and KAMERADSCHAFTSBUND. The fore mentioned Turnenbund is the father organization of over 200 gymnastic societies, the members physical exercise is sprinkled with pan-Germanism and neo-Nazi propaganda through its official publication called 'Bundesturnzeitung'. As for the latter mentioned group it is an Austrian veterans organization and former SS men have a large influence in the Kameradschaftsbund.

It must be noted that one of the worlds foremost anti-Nazis, the man who played a large part in the tracking down of the infamous Adolf Eichmann, lives in Vienna where he directs the Jewish Documentation Center. Simon Wiesenthal a victim of 13 concentration camps devotes his time and energy to tracking down Nazi war criminals.

One of Mr. Wiesenthal's more sensational cases was the discovery of Herr Karl Silberbauer, a police detective in the Vienna Police Department, who was identified as the Gestapo captor of Anne Frank and her family.

Wiesenthal's files list the names of many thousands of Hitler's SS and Gestapo men, professional torturers, concentration camp physicians who used prisoners as guinea pigs, and guards who shot, hanged, gassed or kicked their victims to death.

"They are still free. They live in our midst, some under false names behind the facade of good citizens," Wiesenthal says. "But we flush them out of hiding, one by one, until the last is brought to justice."

Belgium

Belgium because of its sometimes hostile ethnic groups, Flemish and Walloon, has produced a wide variety of ultra-Rightist, neo-Nazi type extremist groups. Certain organizations have ties with the OAS; others may be affiliated with the Malmö or WUNS Nazi Internationals; German neo-Nazi groups have contacts with the Nazi underground in Germany; some have an appeal to the former Congo colonials.

The MOUVEMENT SOCIAL BELGE (MSB) with its publication 'L'Europe Reelle' is connected with the withered Malmö neo-Nazi International. Its leader is former SS man Jean-Robert Debbaudt.

VOLKSUNIE is a Flemish Nationalist group which was formed in 1949 under the name VLAAMSE CONCENTRATIE. Its members include former Belgium collaborators and serious neo-Nazi undertones are present within this political party.

MOUVEMENT d'ACTION CIVIQUE (MAC) was formed in 1960, its publication is called 'Juene Europe'. Its initial appeal was to former Congo colonials and at present is considered to be the most serious and organized Fascist group in Belgium. One of the principal leaders of it is Jean Thiriart a former member of the FRIENDS OF THE GREAT GERMAN REICH who was imprisoned for collaborating with the
