

FUNDRAISING/MERCHANDISING

The primary role of the fundraising group is to support ACT UP/Boston with financial resources: such that the set goals of the organization may be achieved. Funds are raised through special events and merchandising. Merchandise such as T-shirts, buttons, and other paraphernalia are sold locally and to ACT UP chapters nationwide.

ATTITUDE

WOMEN'S ISSUES

This group is currently working on the national Women's Research and Treatment Agenda which is a joint effort by ACT UP chapters nationwide. Another ongoing project is working to change the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) definition of AIDS to be more inclusive of opportunistic infections unique to women.

This group will be going to high schools and teen shelters to distribute and talk about safe sex information and also information concerning I.V. Drug use.
