No wonder the *Jerusalem Post* described the ZOA as "one of the most important and influential Jewish groups in the U.S. today."

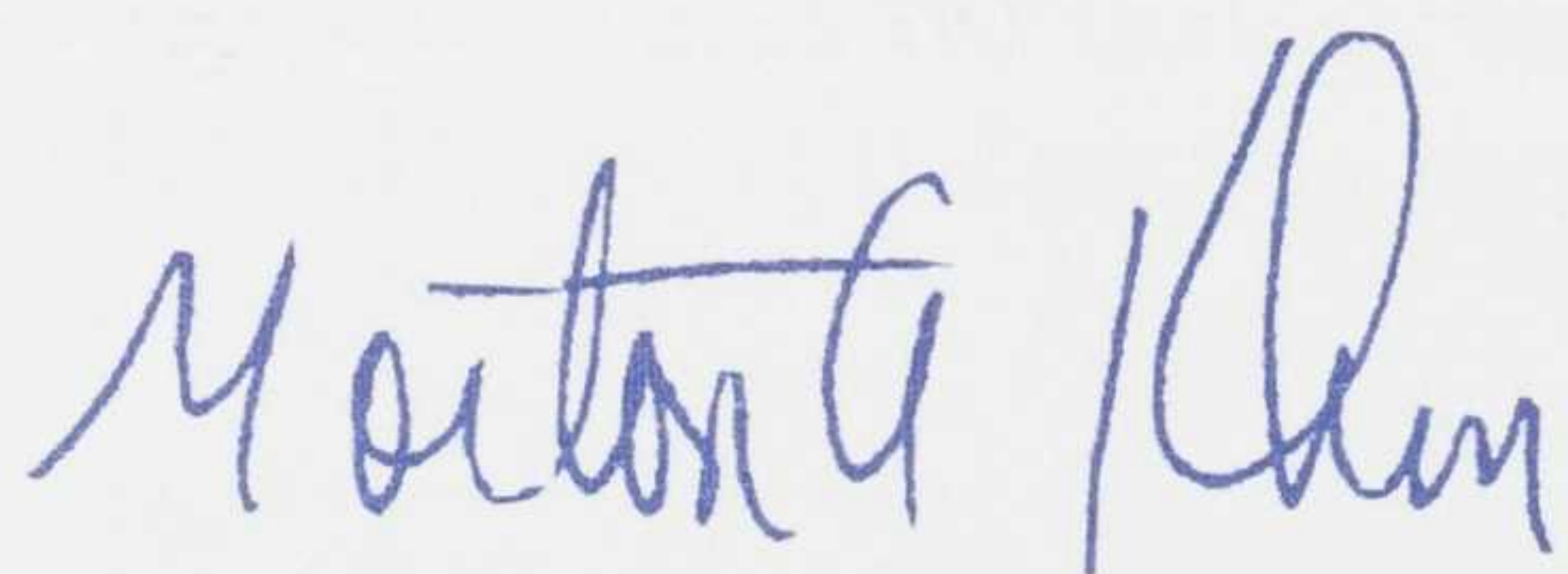
