

Jesus said: "...I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven." Lk. 10:18
Jesus parable of Wheat and tares makes the husbandman say: "...An enemy hath done this." Matt. 13:28

Luke gives us remarkable supernatural insight: "Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot..." Lk. 22:3 Was Judas 'born of serpent seed through Mother Eve' or, did Judas become SATAN possessed?

Note: Bible contrasts between the Holy Spirit & the spirit of evil.

Etc, etc.

The Devil, Satan, Lucifer, The Dragon etc. is neither omnipotent, omniscient, nor omnipresent. Only GOD possesses these qualities...
