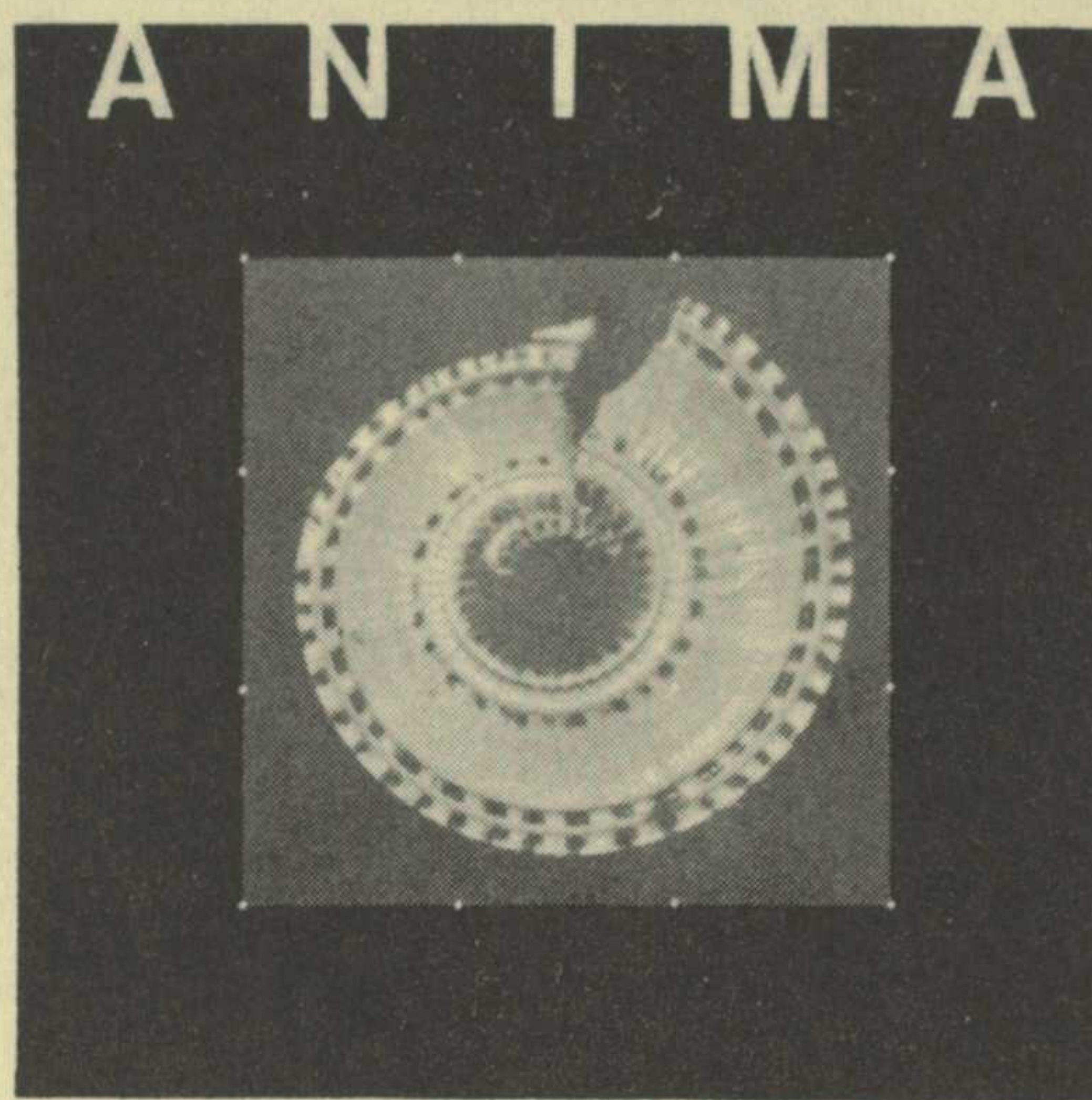

Thank you for your letter of December 29th. Unfortunately, we do not have a brochure which directly answers your questions about ANIMA. With the help of a few enclosures I'll try and describe who we are and what we do.

Basically, we are a small publication house. For the most part we publish books generally in the area of Asian Studies. We also publish the TEILHARD STUDIES for the American Teilhard Association for the Future of Man. This is an organization devoted to the study of the works of Pierre Teilhard de Chardin and which is fervently interested in the preservation of Planet Earth and her inhabitants. You might be interested in some of the Teilhard Studies, especially those by Thomas Berry. All of the T.S. are listed in the 4 page brochure.
