Persecuted, we suffer it.

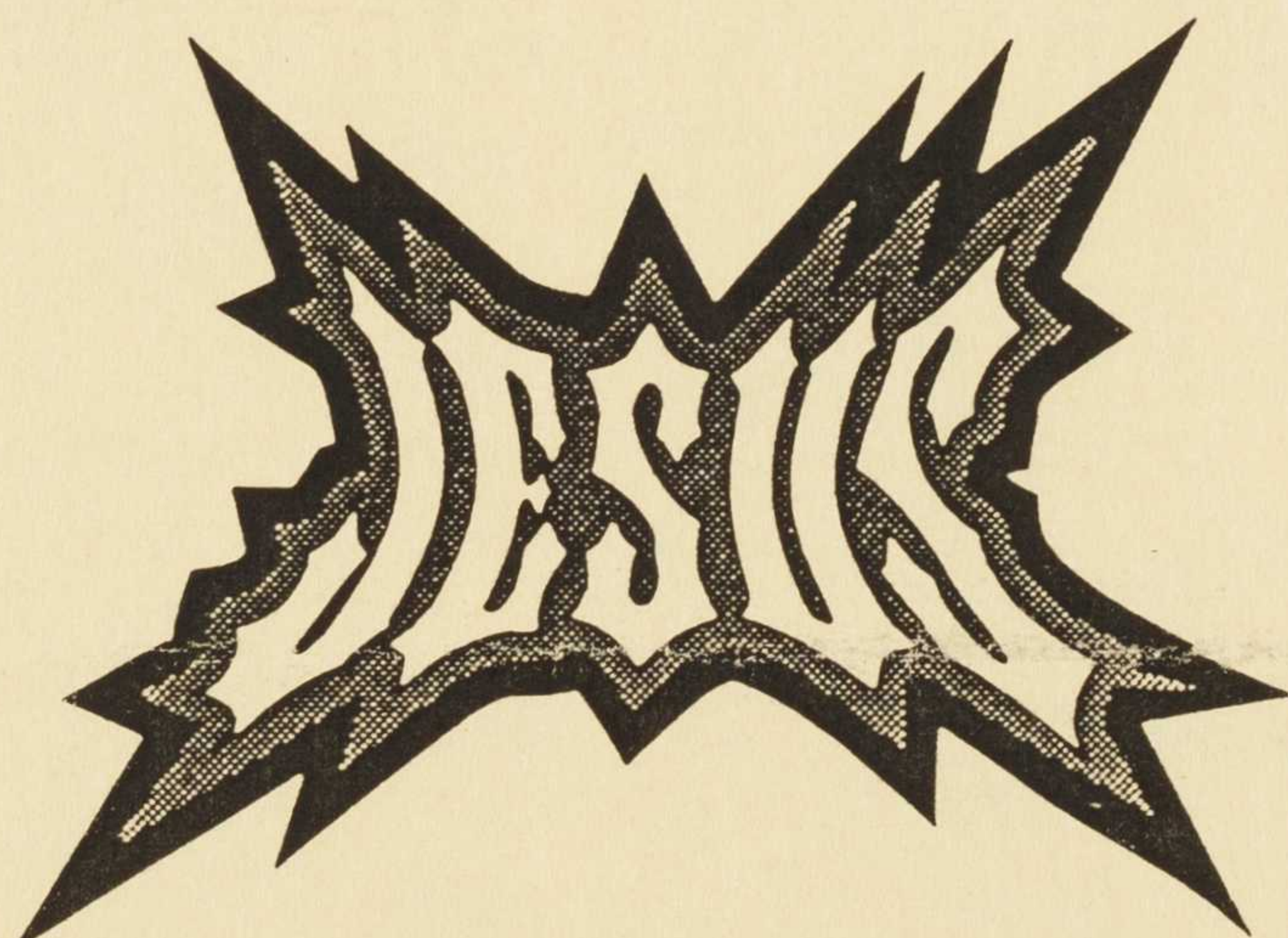
ACTS 9:23 The Jews took counsel to kill him and watched the gates day and night to kill him.
