

WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- ◇ **Write** to Alan C. Nelson, Commissioner, Immigration and Naturalization Service, Room 7100, Chester Arthur Building, 425 Eye Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20336, protesting the denial of resident status to Margaret Randall and demanding review of her case.
- ◇ **Write** to Representative Peter Rodino, who chairs the House Judiciary Committee and to Representative Barney Frank who is a member of the Subcommittee on Immigration of this Committee and urge them on in their efforts to revise immigration procedures. Insist that they put an end to the exclusion of non-citizens on ideological grounds. If you are from Barney Frank's district, it is especially important that he hear from you.
- ◇ **Send** a generous contribution to the Center for Constitutional Rights which has initiated Margaret's case against I.N.S. as well as defending her in the I.N.S. proceedings against her. Checks should be made out to "C.C.R./Randall Case" and sent to the Center for Constitutional Rights, 853 Broadway, New York, NY 10003.
- ◇ **Talk** about Margaret's case with friends, colleagues, and at political meetings. Make people aware of the necessity to resist the climate of increasing intimidation and repression in which the government is enveloping us while it engages in unlawful activities at home and abroad.
