

of the Council. If at least four-fifths of the Council members are present, the amendment may be put to a vote. A two-thirds vote of those present will be required to adopt the amendment.

If at least four-fifths of the members is not present, the proposed amendment may be acted upon at the next regular or special meeting at which a majority of members is present in person or by proxy, provided notice of the amendment to be considered is given in writing to every Council member. If the notice is given by mail, it must be put in the mail at least two weeks before the meeting is to be held. If the notice is delivered personally, it must be delivered at least twelve days prior to the meeting. At such a meeting, a majority vote by those present, either in person or by proxy, will suffice for approval of the amendment.

ARTICLE VIII

Dissolution of the Organization

Should the organization disband, all monies in its possession after paying outstanding obligations shall be refunded to the Council members in the same percentage as their contributions during the current plus the previous fiscal period.
