

for it will be delivered with power and mighty signs and miracles following. They will not preach in churches and synagogues so much, nor under the manipulations of man-made organizations, but will be governed altogether by the Holy Ghost, and their preaching will be in the highways and hedges, much the same as the ministry of Jesus was.

They will not be dependent upon trains, busses and airplanes for transportation, but the Spirit will be their transportation, as the Spirit transported Philip from place to place. They will have the power to appear and disappear at will, as Jesus did. And all the devils in hell will not be able to lay one finger on them. They will not be confined to the use of one language, but all languages will be given them, and they will preach to all tongues, all nations, and all peoples.

Their message will be the "Everlasting Gospel" that John saw the angel fly from heaven with. Rev. 14:6. We sometimes call this Gospel we preach the "everlasting gospel" but not so. This is the gospel of Jesus Christ, or the Gospel of Grace. The "Everlasting Gospel" has not yet come down from heaven.

That "Everlasting Gospel" will contain the answers to all the questions we now ask ourselves and are unable to answer concerning the final plan of the ages. Many things we teach today, concerning the end of time, the tribulation, the Kingdom Age, Heaven and Hell, are built up from the wisdom of men and are inaccurate. Because of our imperfections we cannot understand God's Word perfectly. Imperfection cannot discern perfection. "For We know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect is come then that which is in part shall be done away." 1 Cor. 13:9-10.

"That which is perfect" is the "Measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ." Eph. 4:12. "That

which is perfect" will come to the man child when they are caught up to the Throne of God, and they will return and impart it to the Church when it is in the Wilderness. "in her place where she is nourished for a time, and times, and a half time, from the face of the serpent." Rev. 12:14.

The man child is made up of those men and women who have been washed in the Blood of the Lamb, and are not entangled with the traditions of the elders or the doctrines of men, or the denominations or anything that divides and separates the Body of Christ, but have faith in Christ and follow him only, not being under the domination of men or of man-made organizations. "These are they which were not defiled with women: for they are virgins." (A woman that defiles a man is termed a whore or harlot. In the 17th chapter of Revelation we have a perfect picture of the Great Whore who is the mother of harlots. She is the Roman Catholic Church, and her daughters are the protestant denominations. Our next message will be about her.)

"These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth." (Not following blindly the leadership of some blind leader of the blind, but believing the Words of Jesus when He said, "Howbeit when the Spirit of Truth is come He will guide you into all truth." John 16:13.) "These were redeemed from among men, being the first fruits unto God and to the Lamb." Not redeemed from the dead, but "from among men."

So; although the Church must go through the Tribulation periods, must suffer persecution and many trials, to purge her of her uncleannesses, to break down all divisional walls, all prejudices, conceit, malice; until by the "washing of water by the Word" she has become "sanctified and cleansed, and
