Quite frankly, when the tour left San Francisco a few weeks ago, we didn't have the money to pay for gas, housing, and other costs through the entire 20 cities.

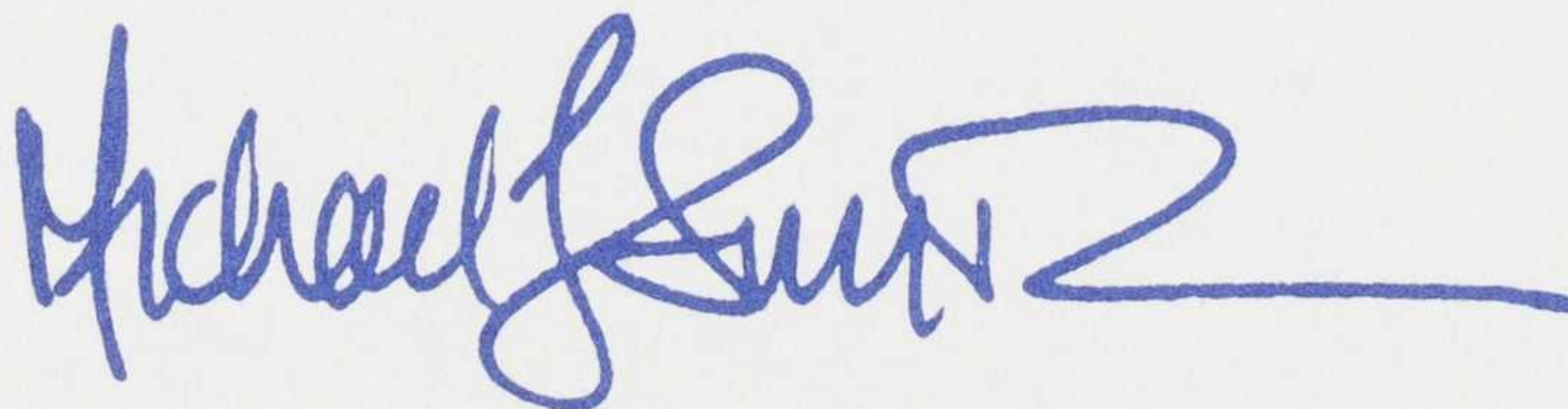
We decided to begin anyway, trusting that as people heard about the Quilt, they would be moved to help finance the tour.
