'Anti-Semitic' student is evicted

COLUMBIA, Mo. (AP) — A University of Missouri student was evicted from his dormitory for displaying swastikas and other anti-Semitic materials in his dormitory room.

George Gruenewald, 21, has until Tuesday to move out of the McDavid Residence Hall after refusing to remove Nazi insignias and passages from Hitler's biography, "Mein Kampf," from his door, university spokesman Ken Brogdon said yesterday.

Gruenewald, a junior, defended the paraphernalia as a display of pride in his German heritage, said Resident Assistant Joel Glaser. Gruenewald said he was proud two of his uncles were Nazi SS officers.

Gruenewald contended his actions were just a joke and that he is not racist or anti-Semitic.

He has indicated he will appeal the decision to the Division of Residential Life's community board, Brogdon said. Brogdon did not know how long it would take for the board to rule on the appeal.

Please note the heading on the article. Immediately Mr. Gruenewald is labelled an Anti-Semite just because he is proud of his Aryan heritage. It is no crime to be proud to be White!!

Painting of Jesus' crucifixion ordered taken off school wall

SYRACUSE, N.Y. (AP) — Federal Judge Howard Munson ordered removal of a painting of Jesus' crucifixion that has hung on the wall of a public school in Schuylerville, N.Y., for 25 years.

Munson ruled the painting conveys a "message of government endorsement of Christianity." A Jewish couple had challenged display of the painting, done by a student in 1965.

It took only one jewish couple to protest a painting of Jesus' crucifixion to be removed from a public school. Has it ever occurred to Judge Munson that that the painting is artwork done by a student some 25 years ago. Mr. Elfin was correct when he stated jews enjoy much political clout in an unequal proportion to non-jews. There is something definitely wrong with this. Does the word "ZOG" ring a bell?
