SUBJECT: Resettlement Projects in the State of Para

Inquiries made at the Governor's office and at the office of the Secretary for Agriculture showed that not too much is known about these projects in higher government circles.

Information developed indicates that to date some 1,042 persons have been brought into the colony as settler of which slightly less than half are actual workers, the others being dependents. These have been settled at the following points:

Altamira	275
Capitao Poço	236
Santarem	204
Alenquer	327

The Agriculture Department states that they have had very good results with these resettlements and are more than satisfied with the outcome. They signaled out Altamira as having exceptionally good results.

Most of the cost of settling these people has apparently been borne by the State of Para. Now, however, they are embarking on a program to be financed primarily by the national government through the Inst. Nacional de Desolvimento Agrario (INDA) in which about 1,200 persons are to be brought into the state from Ceara this year. Of these 62 have already been processed.

Another plan for colonization, also to be heavily subsidized by the national government, calls for the introduction of 400 nordestinos into Para each year. These latter will be provided with all the equipment necessary to colonize new lands.

Senhor Cônsul :

Em consideração ao seu ofício de 6 de julho corrente, temos a satisfação de informar o seguinte:

1. Até a presente data já foram introduzidas em nosso Estado 1.042 pessoas, entre colonos e seus familiares, calculando-se que deste número de pessoas cerca de 45% sejam de colonos autônticos.
2. O programa em apreço destina-se ao povoamento puro e simples de regiões rarefeitas. Todavia, elaboramos dois programas cuja execução dependerá mais do Governo Federal que do Estadual, uma vez que somente poderá ser realidade se for custeado pelo INDA. Tratam-se, um de trabalho puro e simples de povoamento, prevendo-se a introdução ainda este ano de 1.200 pessoas, das quais já foram introduzidas 62, e o outro, de colonização racional, contando com todos os requisitos dos trabalhos de extensão agrícola, garantirá a abertura de colônias modelos com a introdução anual de 400 colonos selecionados no Nordeste.
