Dear Fellow Workers:

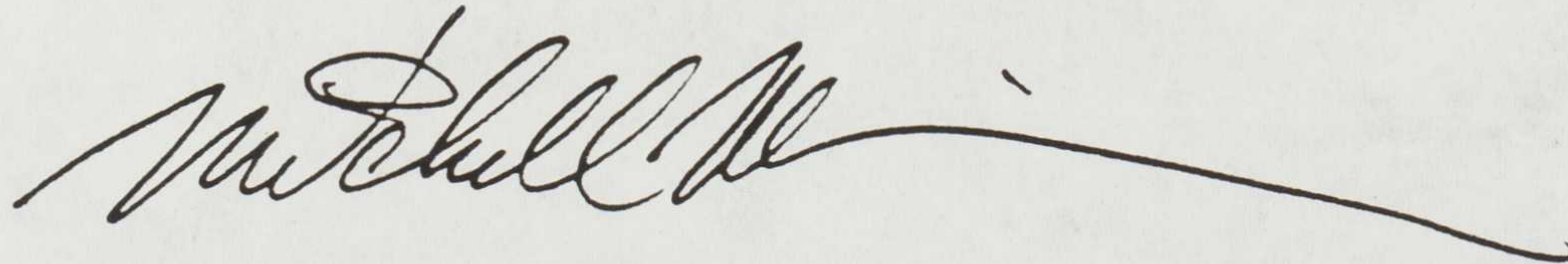
Greetings on behalf of the Workers Solidarity Alliance, United States Section of the International Workers Association.
