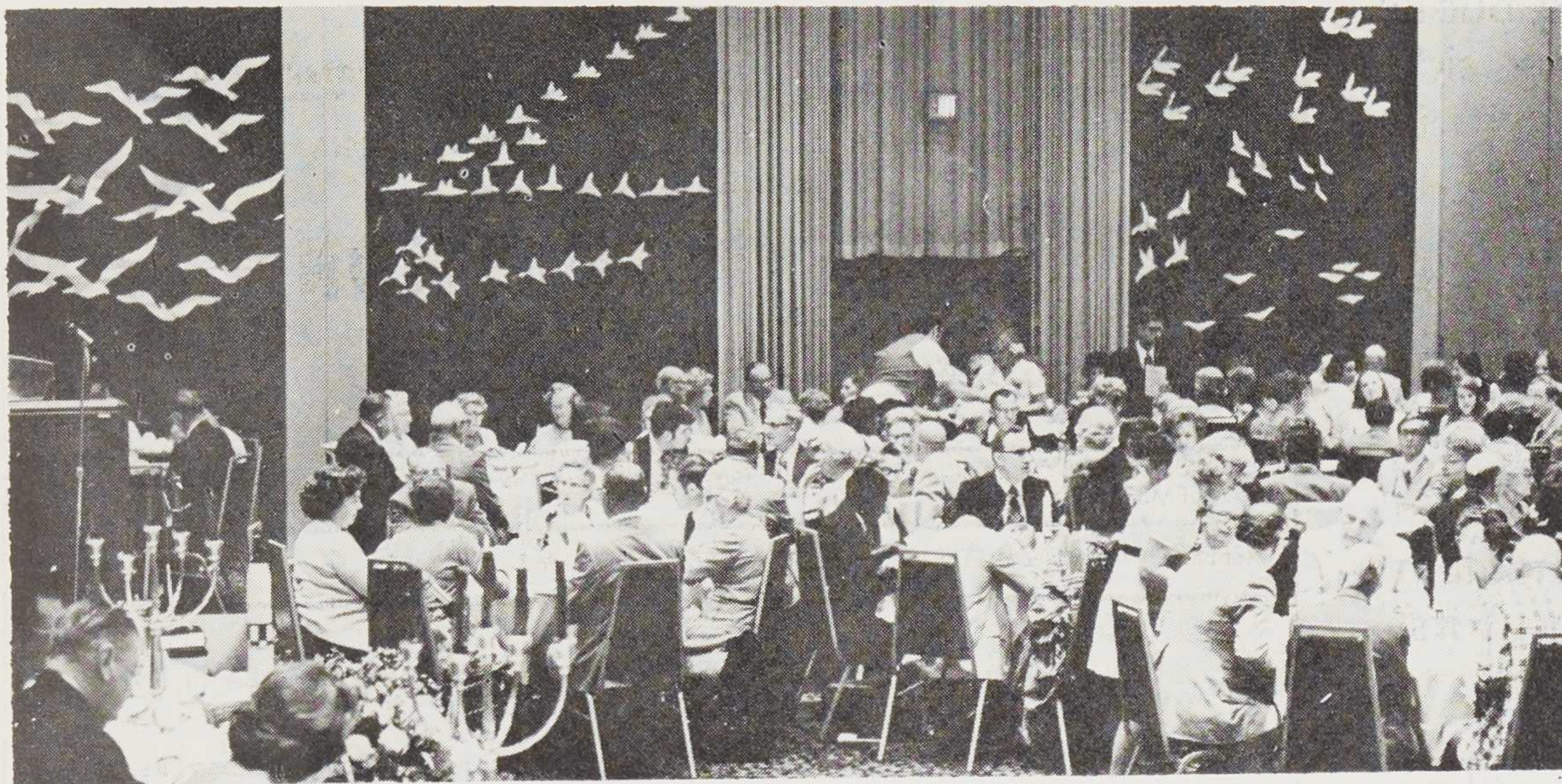

December 27, 1974, Cape Canaveral is purchased with the million-dollar check

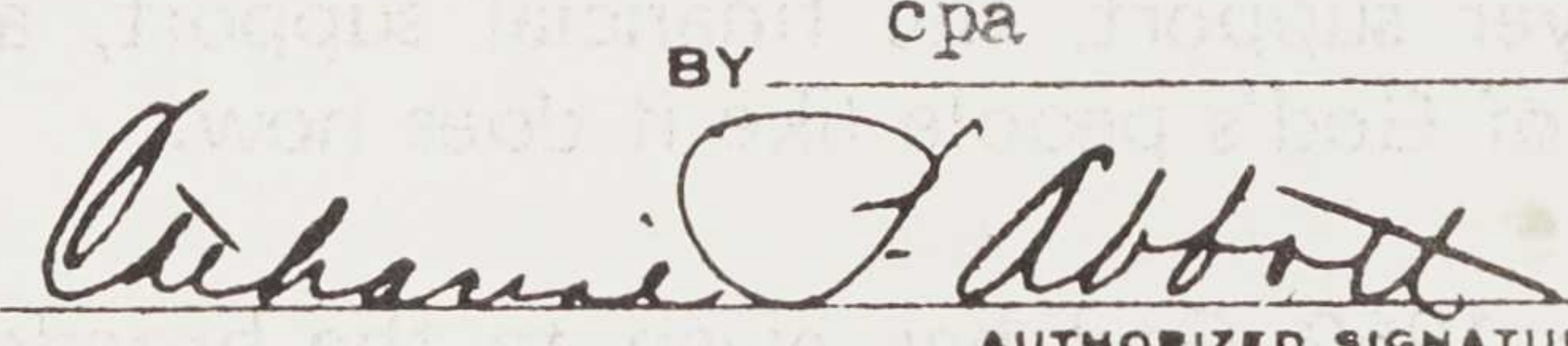
the phony Russian churchmen who came to the U.S. under the sponsorship of the NCC.

In all these years I have never typed out and read a broadcast. Some documents I have read, of course. But I have spoken extemporaneously in the gifts that God has given me to let the personal emphasis that comes by conversation, change of tempo, and hard-hitting thrust have their impact in the hearts of men. "Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty," and "the word of God is not bound." One thing has been certain. Only God knows the souls that have been saved, the people who have separated from the great apostasy, and those who have arisen to help save our beloved country from confusion, disaster, and destruction at the hands of her enemies, especially the Communists and their allies and dupes.

When WVCH dropped us, I lost our "home base station." It affected everything. This is exactly what our enemies wanted. The Almighty God who is with us and on whose promises we stand, led us to put a

mortgage on the beautiful Faith Theological Seminary property of \$425,000, and WXUR was purchased for \$450,000 in order that the 20th Century Reformation Hour could be heard in the Philadelphia area. At this point the same pressures that had succeeded in removing us from WVCH arose throughout the Philadelphia area asking the FCC not to transfer the license. This was provoked by the church groups affiliated with National Council of Churches and the Anti-Defamation League. These elements have been working together against us through these years. The United Church of Christ under Dr. Everett Parker was a part of this action, and this is the group now that represents all of these ecumenical interests in seeking to restrict genuine gospel broadcasting in the United States.

These were the interests that got Joshua Eilberg, a member of the House of Representatives of the State of Pennsylvania, and now in the U.S. Congress, to push the famous Resolution 160 through that body, asking the FCC to investigate station WXUR. The Resolution called our ideas "dangerous."
