Four titles were added to the A.J. Muste Memorial Institute Pamphlet Series this year; in all, a dozen pamphlets on historical and current issues of concern to social change activists and scholars are available.

Our new additions are:

- *Science, Liberty and Peace*, by Twentieth Century visionary *Aldous Huxley*
- *The Morality of Scientific Technology; the Psychology of Being Powerless*, by *Paul Goodman*, noted activist/pacifist/anarchist
- *Some Writings on War Tax Resistance*, including thoughts, poems, and tales from such resisters as *Juanita Nelson*, *Allen Ginsberg*, and *Pete Seeger*
- Six articles on peace and labor, by *Sidney Lens*, prolific peace and labor organizer/socialist political activist and candidate.

They join the eight pamphlets published previously, containing writings by *Barbara Deming*, *Martin Luther King, Jr.*, *Henry David Thoreau*, *Jessie Wallace Hughan*, *Emma Goldman*, *Rosa Luxemburg*, *A.J. Muste*, and a group of activists confronting the issue of wars of liberation from a nonviolent perspective.

The pamphlets are \$1 each; 70 cents when ten or more are purchased.

Also available from the Institute is *Peace Agitator*, *Nat Hentoff's* classic biography of A.J. Muste, with an introduction by historian Larry Gara and many photographs of A.J. and his fellow activists. The book is \$6.50 each; \$3.90 when ten or more are purchased.
