

This movement would, we propose, be aggressive and radical. It should reject the cooperative attitude of the current trade unions. It should coordinate its efforts with all other sectors of the working class, both here and abroad. It should take the offensive in building a free and better world. It can only be in a world controlled by the people who do the work, not the bosses, State or political parties, in which we can ultimately attain what's best for ourselves, our families and our class.

If you are tired of the bosses and the union bureaucrats setting the agenda, let's build the kind of independent working class movement that will allow us to set our agenda and wage our fight.

WHAT IS WSA?

WSA, or WORKERS SOLIDARITY ALLIANCE, is a national organization advocating rank-and-file-controlled, action-oriented associations, in workplaces and communities, as a means to social change. We believe that this strategy--called anarcho-sindicalism--is the only way to achieve a society in which workers collectively control the economy for the common benefit.

Our members are active in a variety of areas, including struggles for rank-and-file workers' rights, environmental safety, racial and sexual equality, and opposition to militarism/U.S. intervention.

WSA is the U.S. affiliate of the International Workers Association, a worldwide federation of revolutionary libertarian labor groups.
