Dear Friend:

I write this letter in the mood of a family doctor who comes out of the bedroom of a sick mother who has five children and tells the husband and the other members of the family that the mother could live and she might die. The doctor, being a Christian, says "The day of miracles has not passed. We must all do our best and if it be God's will, she will live.

The above is a simile which defines my attitude toward the present situation involving the destiny of Christian civilization, the future of our beautiful America and the preservation of everything we hold dear involving our relationship to the rest of the world.

The Government of the United States is now in the hands of the most ruthless gang of assassins since the Middle Ages. Similiar situations existed during the more modern history of England as well as France and other nations during the fifteenth and sixteenth centuries when public figures and individual citizens were beheaded by the guillotine, burned at the stake and hanged in public because of their political viewpoints. The population was so calloused and hardened that the wives of public figures would sit near the guillotine with their knitting needles and take a stitch in their knitting only when a head dropped to the ground from the guillotine.

In recent months response to our mailings has created a crisis that makes it necessary for me to write you asking for a vote of confidence - I have dedicated my life in the fight against communism. I have withstood the actions of the enemies of our nation - but I can do nothing about weaklings who insist on retiring from the fight, giving up and surrendering, but I can say to those who are determined to stand with me in the exposition of truth which cannot be answered that we will very likely win the ultimate victory in the sight of all men, but regardless of what we win or lose, we will have been the victors by the preservation of our own self-respect.

Thus far we have continued in the fight, at a continued and ever mounting loss, and with the help of God and our patriotic friends we will continue! But - we need your help as we are helplessly in debt and cannot continue in the struggle without your vote of confidence.

I am writing this letter to you as a last resort. I have been spending sleepless nights worrying about the stack of unpaid bills lying on my desk. Tears well to my eyes when I think of being forced to quit after dedicating my life in the struggle against Communism.
