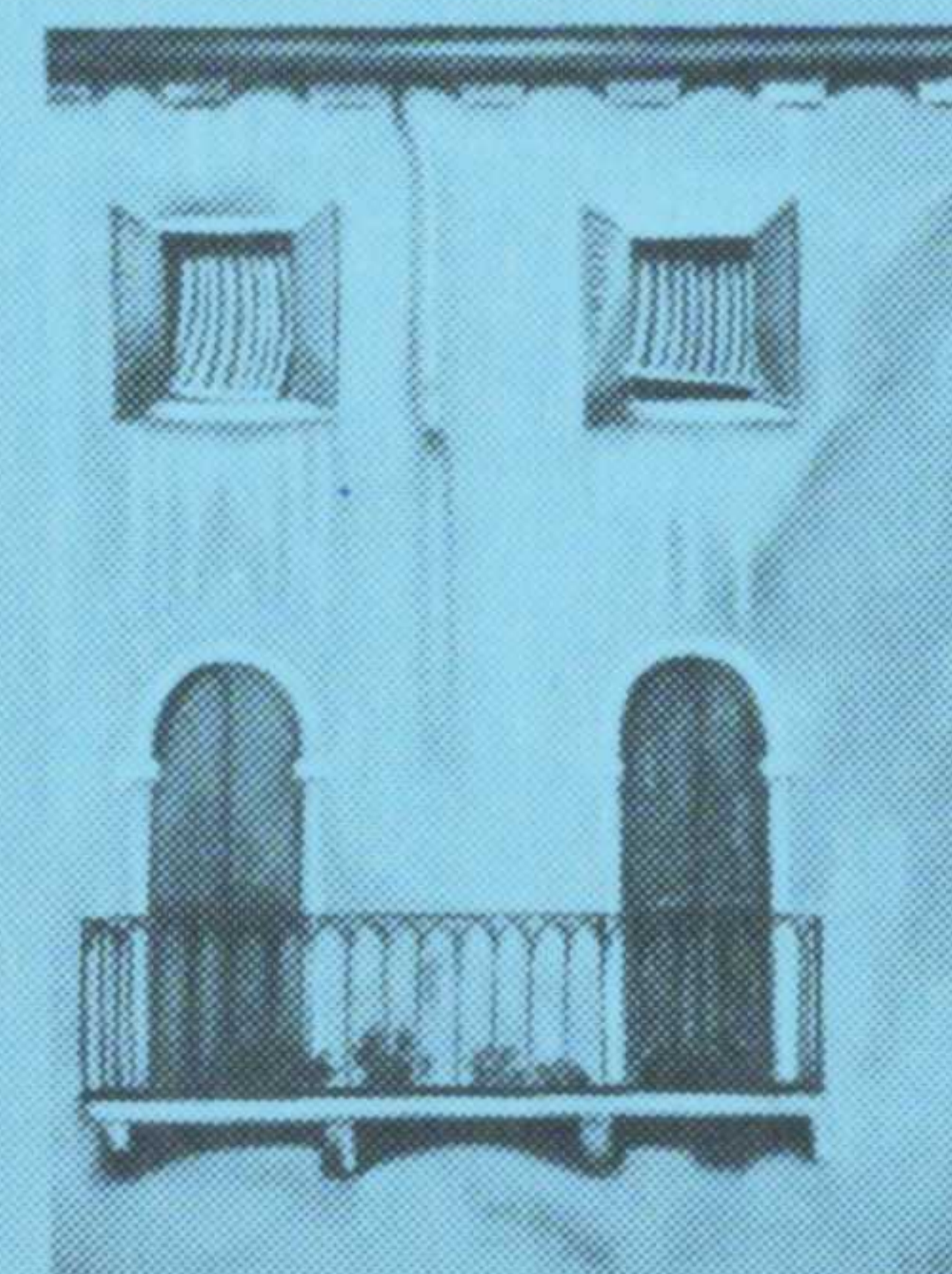
Simply and sensually written, this love story between two divorced Mexican Jewish women has been both scandalous and celebrated since its first publication
