

learned from Jacob's blessing that Joseph in the end time was to be alone, separate from his brethren.

These blessings were to come to Joseph's land, "the precious things." "For the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep that coucheth beneath." This, of course, refers to all of the blessings that God has poured upon this land — wealth, natural resources, spiritual blessings, mental blessings, freedom and opportunity.

"And for the precious fruits brought forth by the sun, and for the precious things put forth by the moon." This refers to food — fruit, vegetables and all foodstuffs in general. This we have in over abundance when compared with that of other nations.

"And for the chief things of the ancient mountains, and for the precious things of the lasting hills" — minerals and other natural resources like timber and so forth.

"And for the precious things of the earth and the fulness thereof, and for the good will of him that dwelt in the bush: let the blessing come upon the head of Joseph, and upon the top of the head of him that was separated from his brethren."

Who dwelt in the bush? Moses heard God speak from the burning bush, so he is saying here that the good will of God, His goodness, blessing and abundance "be upon the head of Joseph" and his land.

It is interesting to note that both Jacob and Moses when blessing Joseph referred to the fact that Joseph was separated from his brethren. This indicates that in the end of the age, "the last days," Joseph's land would be separated from the

Old World and from other Anglo-Saxon or Israel people.

"His glory is like the firstling of his bullock." The glory of a nation is its strength, its defenses.

"And his horns are like the horns of unicorns: with them he shall push the people together to the ends of the earth." Isn't this tremendous? What has this Joseph nation done in two World Wars, and what is it doing right now to aggressive, anti-Christ and heathen forces and unscriptural civil administrations, worldwide? We have done the very thing we read in verse 17 of Deuteronomy 33. The verse closes with "they are the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they are the thousands of Manasseh" (Joseph's sons).

Here again we find, as we do throughout all Bible prophecy, that the United States of America, with its virtues and its good characteristics as well as its sins and weaknesses of the flesh, is fulfilling all of these prophecies.

With this in mind I want to call your attention to what happened two days later when the Lord Jesus Christ took the form of man and came upon earth's scene. (And remember, one day is like a thousand years and a thousand years as one day with the Lord.) I'm using the expression "two days later" in this sense. It is also well to keep in mind that it is only four days ago, reckoning time this way, since God made these great covenants and promises with the fathers.

Jesus speaks a parable in Matthew 21. He tells of His vineyard and what was to happen to Him. He here prophesied that He would be killed by the religious leaders of that day. This happened just as prophesied.
