What do you know of the Person of Christ?

Has His 'Identity' been revealed to you?

Every Christian MUST OF NECESSITY be introduced to the Four Gospels! The sacred record of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John is the powerhouse of Holy Scripture.

Christology has its 'roots;' not in the Epistles, but in the Gospels.

"For me the archives are Jesus Christ, the inviolate archives are His Cross and His Death and His Resurrection and the Faith which is through Him." So wrote St. Ignatius.

According to St. Paul, Christ is: "...the power of God and the wisdom of God." A person who knows not the Scripture knows not God's power and His wisdom. Ignorance of the Scripture is ignorance of Christ.

The Apostles doctrine of the Person of Christ is the most momentous in the whole realm of thought, on it everything else depends...

The New Testament presents the facts about His [Jesus'] Person, rather than any attempted explanations of them, but the Gospels indicate that the historical Christ claimed to be both God and Man, and from the Acts of The Apostles and the Epistles it is clear that the earliest Christians regarded Him as such.

The supreme subject of Christianity---WHO WAS JESUS OF NAZARETH?

CHRISTOLOGY: A technical theological word meaning: The study of the Person of Christ, and in particular of the union in Him of the Divine and human natures.

When Jesus came to earth He did not cease to be God; when He returned to Heaven He did not cease to be man. Let us 'think' on these things.

Apostolic Christology believes and trusts the Messianic prophecies in the Old Testament, receives the testimony of Christ in the Gospels, the teaching of the Apostles in Acts, Epistles and the Revelation. It accepts the writings of St. Paul as inspired, inerrent records.

For us to be Christocentric is to understand...The FATHER who spoke by His prophets must COME to save in the Son and must OCCUPY in the Holy Spirit.

The LORD JESUS CHRIST is the Master miracle! God's perfect man---man's perfect God! Do you believe this? HE WAS NOT half-a-God and half-a-man; He was perfectly God and perfectly Man...
