Castello Branco Comments on Rele of Foreign Capital

1. Spenking to a visiting National Mar College class in Brasilia on March 17, President CASTELLO BRANCO touched on the role of fereign capital in Brasil. The President said that he understood foreign investment was made in Brasil in order to make money, an Brasilians also hope to make money from it.

2. Commenting that his administration favored foreign investment, Castello Branco then posed the following rhetorical questions:
