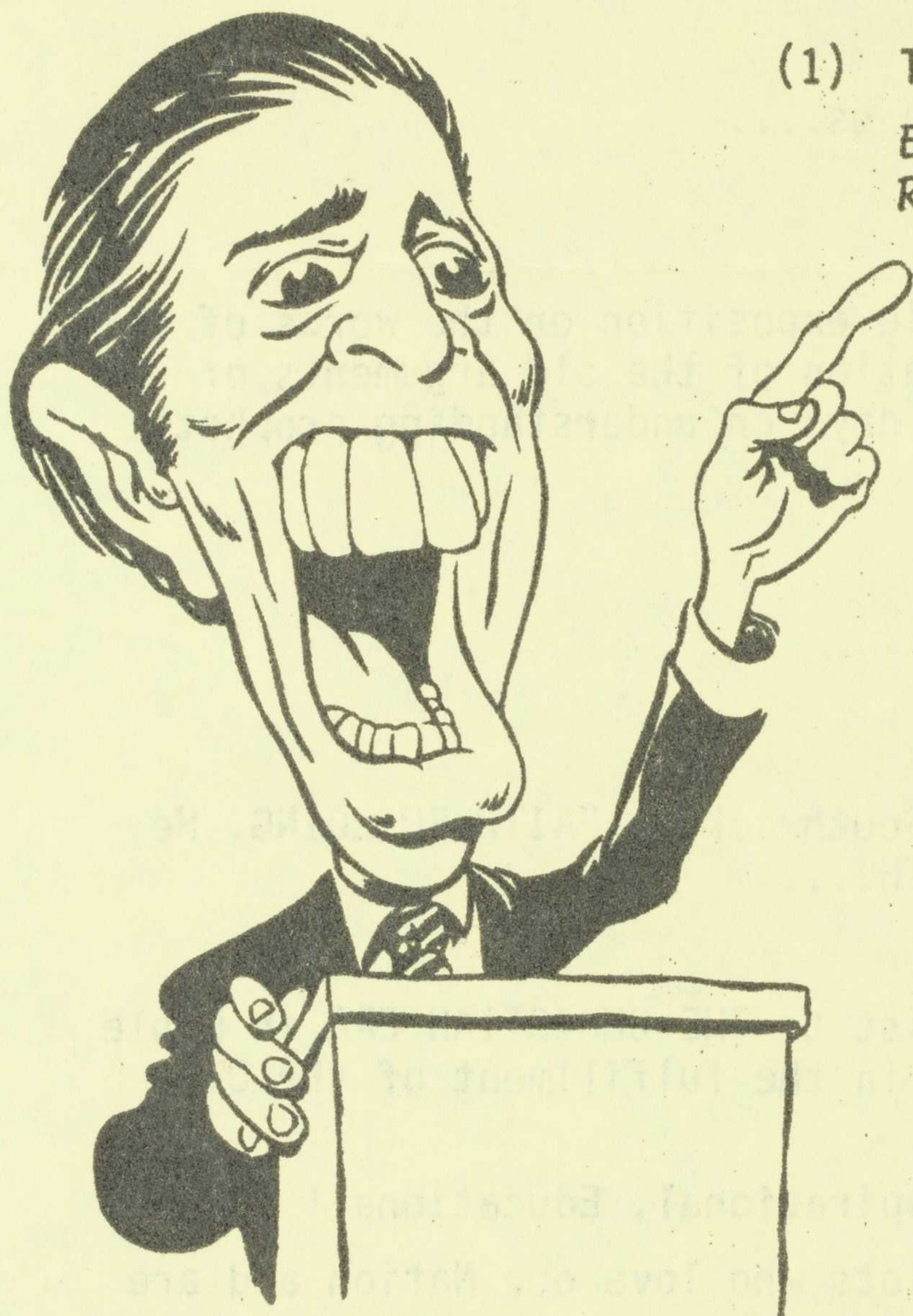


FALSE PROPHETS AND THEIR RELIGIOUS LIES....

"Behold, the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord. And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the Lord, and shall not find it."

(1) THAT THE JEWS ARE THE CHOSEN PEOPLE OF GOD.

Exactly the opposite is true---For they are CHRIST REJECTORS! And, as Preachers preach, the one who rejects Christ is lost, (ie: goes to hell) What kind of doctrine is this? Further, it is a blot on the wisdom of the Almighty---It seems He does not know what He is doing!

(2) THAT WE ARE NOT UNDER THE LAW BUT UNDER GRACE.

This is ANTINOMIANISM, or, Lawlessness. Luther bitterly condemned this view. It is the error propounded by the Darby-Plymouth Brethren and their teaching. This is not the view of the Reformers. To reject one part of the Old Testament (Exodus 20) is to pick and choose what we want to believe....GOD ALMIGHTY gave the LAW to Israel at Mt. Sinai...Who might you be to say it is 'done away'?It is the ORDINANCES that are fulfilled and done away! In Christ!

(3) THAT THE CHURCH CONSTITUTES THE KINGDOM.

The church is no more the kingdom of God than the Bride of Christ is---'A gentile bride!' This is Roman Catholic teaching that has survived the Reformation. By substituting the church for the kingdom millions of people have lost the central teaching of Scripture.

(4) THAT THE CHURCH WILL BE RAPTURED OUT OF THIS WORLD IN THE END TIME.

Here is the 'lollypop' of modern evangelical Christianity! Take this doctrine away and you will pay! This theological falsehood has neutralized and blinded multitudes of otherwise good Christian people.

Such people are so heavenly-minded they are of no earthly good! For they are planning on getting....'The Heaven out of here!' So they have no concern about the great Babylonian system now engulfing our people socially, politically, religiously and economically. The 'rapture-minded' could care less about the future of our American people and the Republic! They do not want the Kingdom to come upon earth---No! They are planning on going to heaven! Well documented evidence by Christian Scholarship reveals this doctrine was an invention of Rome and taken up and propagated by the Plymouth-Brethren sect.
