What else can I do to HELP?

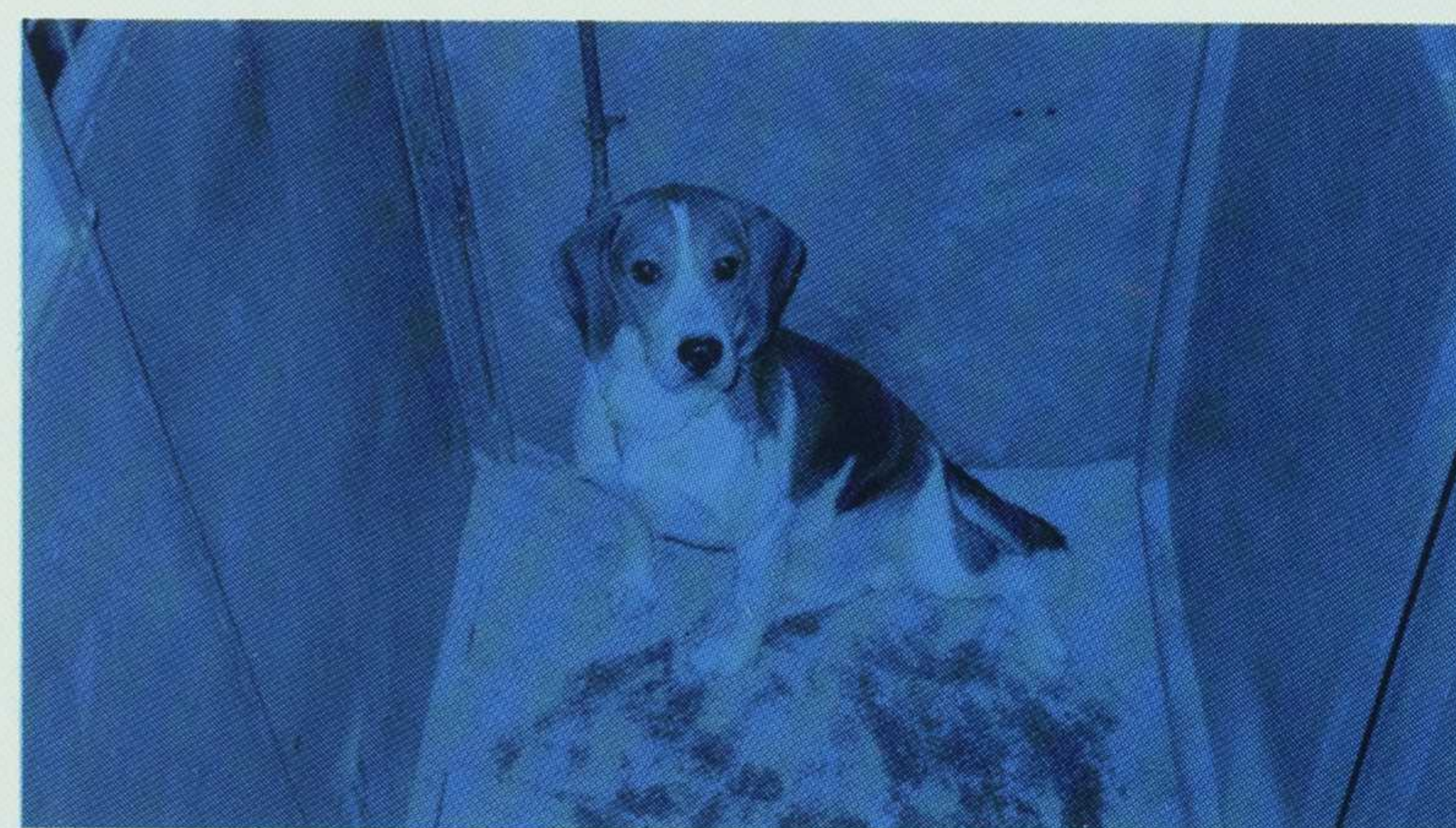
- Inform yourself. Joining the AAVS is a good way to keep in touch with developments and news. Tell others about our vital work.
