

#3 - We're Providing Important Services:

For Grantees

Bread and Roses periodically provides non-monetary services to its grantees. Through a special Funding Exchange arrangement with LOTUS we are offering 60 grantees free computer software. More than a dozen groups have already signed up.

In partnership with the Philadelphia Foundation, Bread and Roses sponsored two March training sessions run by Kim Klein, author of *Fundraising for Social Change* and editor of *The Grassroots Fundraising Journal*. Over 75 people from more than 35 organizations participated in the sessions which covered fundraising planning, activating Boards, how to ask for money, and much more.
