Endorsement Campaign: With the Navy's decision date receding into the future, and with news that Boston can uninvite the Navy - even after the basing decision has been made - we have adjusted our organizing strategy to a longer term frame of reference. 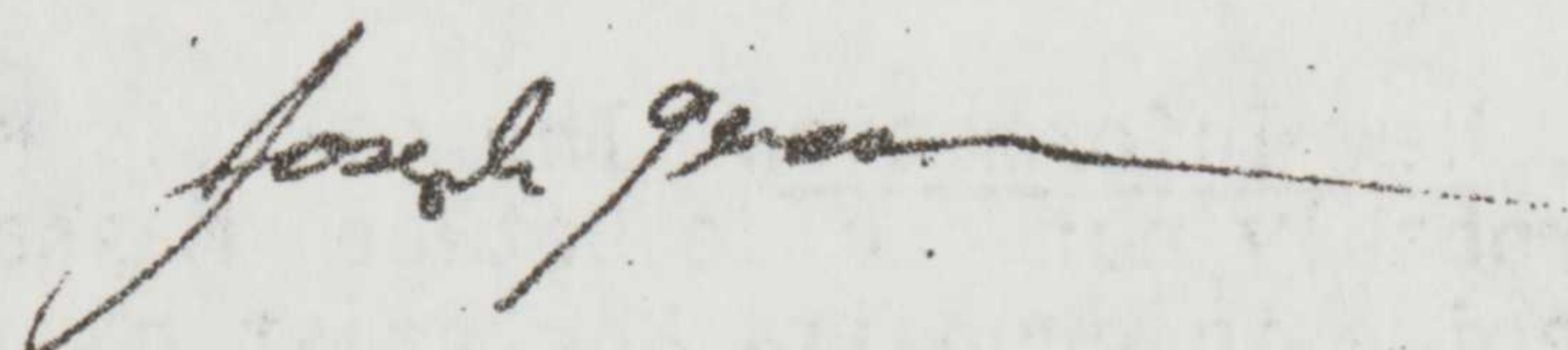
6. August 6-9: The August 6th Action Committee will be conducting a Peace procession with a focus on stopping the deployment of cruise missiles in Boston Harbor. The procession begins at Faneuil Hall at 11 am. Following a short march to Waterfront Park, it will conclude with a symbolic action on the waterfront involving a small flotilla of boats organized by Greenpeace. On August 9 there will be leafletting and picketing at the State House.

7. Task Forces: Our six task forces are meeting regularly and doing their work. They include: outreach, environment & safety, media, elected officials, jobs & economy, religious and fund raising. If you have the time to work with a task force, please let us know.

8. New Resources: The Ad Hoc Committee is in the process of developing a number of new resources. These include a detailed background paper about the Iowa Task Force, a leaflet for popular distribution, a brochure about the Ad Hoc Committee, and fact sheets relating to jobs & economy, the freeze & arms control, environment & safety, and foreign intervention.
