

Section 3. (a) The National Director can be impeached by a majority (over half) vote of the membership of ASP through the pages of the Party's internal publication.

(b) 10% of the membership's signatures gathered on a petition endorsed by a majority of one Organizing Committee is required for an impeachment of the National Director.

(c) In case of the impeachment or resignation of the National Director, a new National Director shall be appointed by the former National Director.

(d) All restrictions of the office of National Director shall apply to any one who has either served the term of office in whole or part.

Section 4. (a) The National Director has the power to appoint a temporary National Organizing Committee, which, if he so wish to appoint a NOC, shall be dissolved on July 4, 1993, when the First White Workers Congress shall be held.

(b) All temporary NOC members shall be able to run for any NOC office they decide, once the temporary NOC has been dissolved.

Section 5. The office of National Director shall be held by Wyatt Clay Kaldenberg.

ARTICLE VIII National Headquarters

Section 1. The National Headquarters of the ASP shall be located in the area of San Diego, California.

Section 2. (a) The National Headquarters of ASP may be move out side of the San Diego, California area if a majority (over half) of the members present at a White Workers' Congress vote to relocate it.

(b) A majority of the NOC signatures shall be required in order to bring a vote on relocating the National Headquarters to the floor of the White Workers' Congress.

ARTICLE IX National Organizing Committee

Section 1. A National Organizing Committee composed of nine members shall conduct the agitational, educational, organizational, and executive work of the Party.

Section 2. (a) The NOC shall be elected for a two year term, starting July 4, 1993, by the following procedures: Two months prior to the White Workers' Congress the National Office shall canvass the Organizing Committees within a 150 mile radius of San Diego, California for the names of ASP members eligible for
