

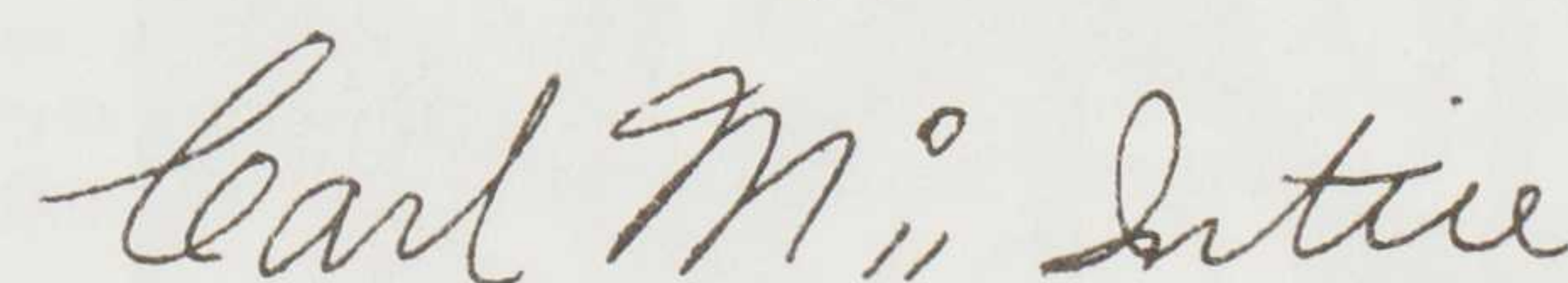
Stations are coming to me asking for my program. Thank God there are stations which are not afraid. But at the recent meeting of the National Religious Broadcasters Association in Washington, Dr. Clyde Taylor of the National Association of Evangelicals introduced a resolution condemning the extremists of the "left and the right." He was following this same line which IAD has here presented. There were enough fair-minded radio station owners present to refuse to adopt the section dealing with the attack upon us! "Much chat at the Washington, D. C., meetings centered on the campaign of one of these, the Rev. Carl McIntire, against the Federal Communications Commission and its 'fairness doctrine' curbing personal attacks. NRB has no official policy in this matter." An article in Christianity Today, February 16, said: "NRB's efforts to win FCC respect and maintain freedom for broadcasting of the Gospel apparently have a foreign counterpart, John Norris, the McIntire ally whose domestic station is fighting 'fairness' before the U.S. Supreme Court . . ." The resolution of this NAE association of broadcasters was considered simply a routine affair until one of the broadcasters present arose and began to denounce it as "dishonest" and a "cheap" political maneuver. What will men not do to win the favor of the FCC! And Dr. Carl Henry, editor of Christianity Today, in a speech attacked what he called "personal abuse and irresponsible indictments by radical extremists who abandon logic midway for exaggeration and misconstruction." The campaign is on to try to discredit those of us who are presenting the righteousness of God to this nation, for it will exalt a nation, and exposing these evil forces which are here to destroy all that we hold dear as Christians and God-fearing Americans.

The fight is on to destroy us by smear, abuse, and accusation. The squeeze is on. This will be seen more and more. I want to get this information into your hands so you can realize what is involved. Now, our answer to all this is our firm, militant exposure of Communism and all the forces which are denying our faith and impugning the place of God in our lives and in His universe.

I ask you to help now, immediately. First, give me the station to which you are listening; second, write me that letter that I have asked for, please; third, join in the great missionary appeal in sending out the Christian Beacon—3 for \$5, 7 for \$10; and fourth, become a regular monthly supporter in as large an amount as you possibly can. Increase what you have been doing, if you can. And finally, help us get new stations—\$1,000 will get me started on a new station tomorrow. Let's meet our enemies with all that we have.

In a very real sense this type of attack by Steve Allen is a compliment. We are hurting somebody and hurting them badly! Praise the Lord! The exposure of evil is a Scriptural duty. "Have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them," and "whatsoever doth make manifest is light." Our enemies are working. We must work harder. America is worth saving. Thank you, my friend.
