OVERVIEW OF EXCHANGE

Denver, Colorado having implemented a practical trainee exchange with one of its sister cities, Brest France in 1985 received a grant from SCI to "augment" their previous exchange, receiving and sending 2 trainees each way.

The two inbound trainees both worked in local businesses in the areas of marketing and management. They were specifically interested in working for large nationwide businesses in order to learn how large "chain" businesses market and manage their concerns nationwide.

One outbound trainee having completed her degree in international banking worked for a bank in Brest, France. The other trainee is being actively sought at the time of this report and will be sent to Brest by the end of 1987.
