

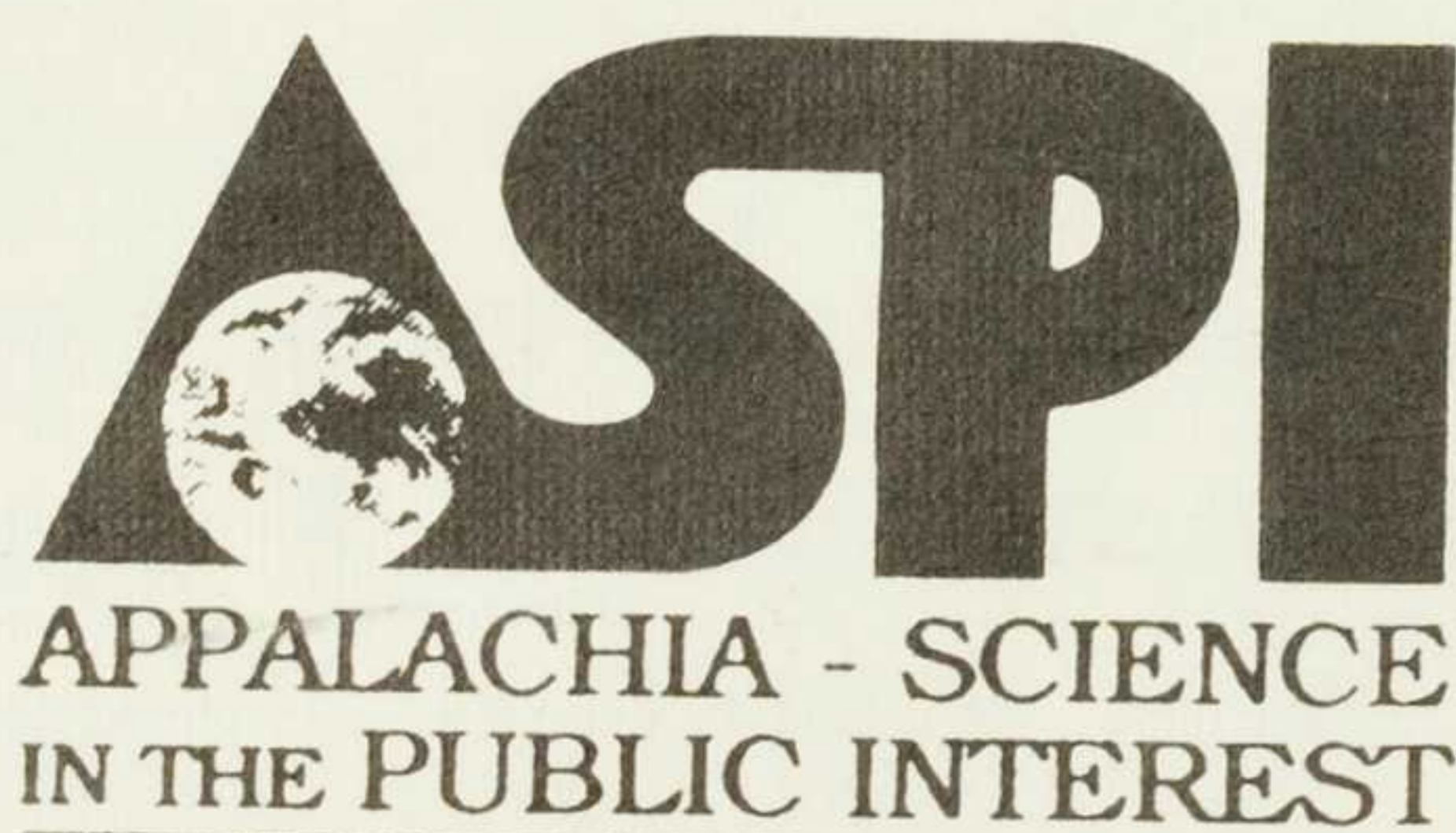
Other Notes
