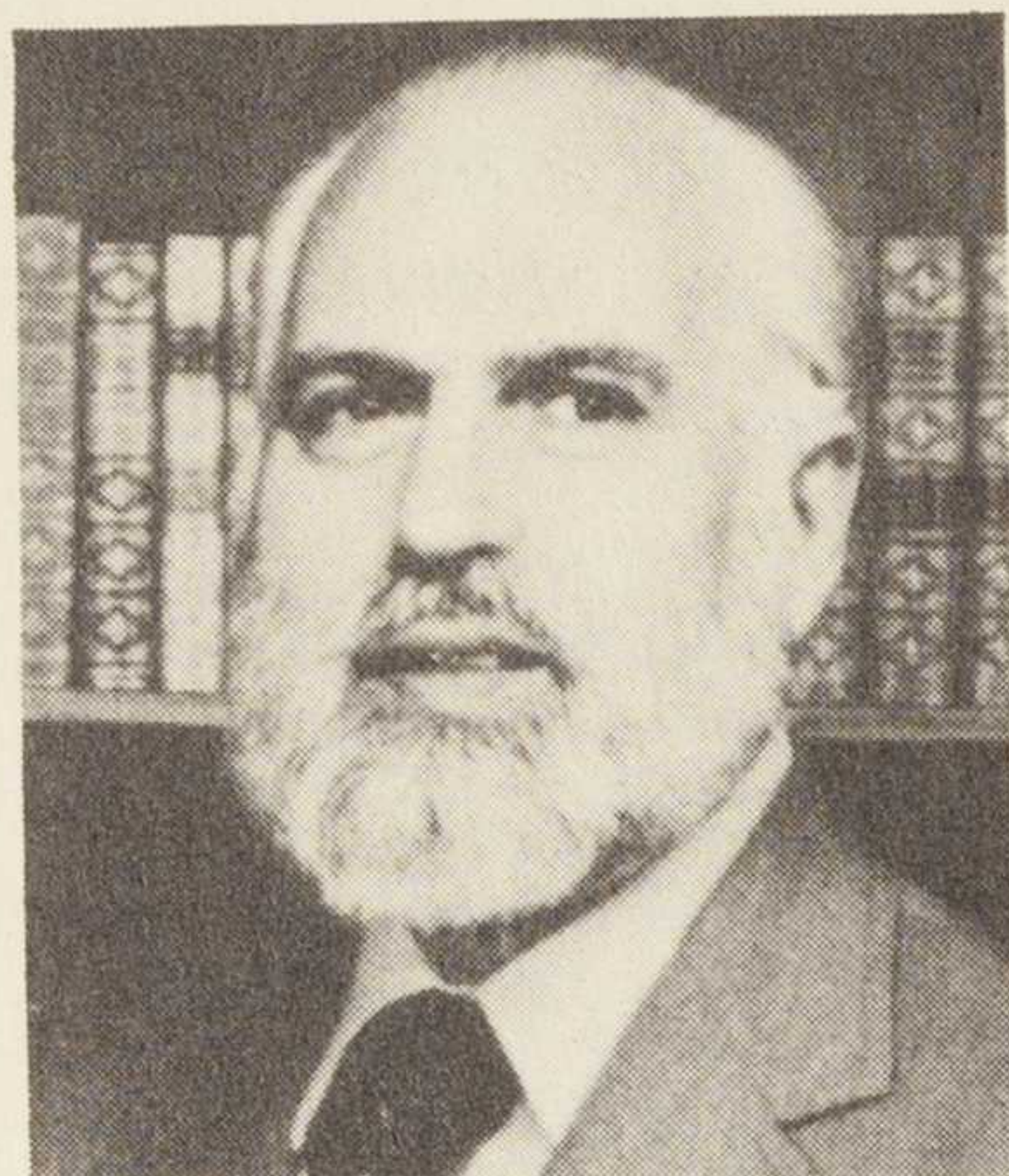

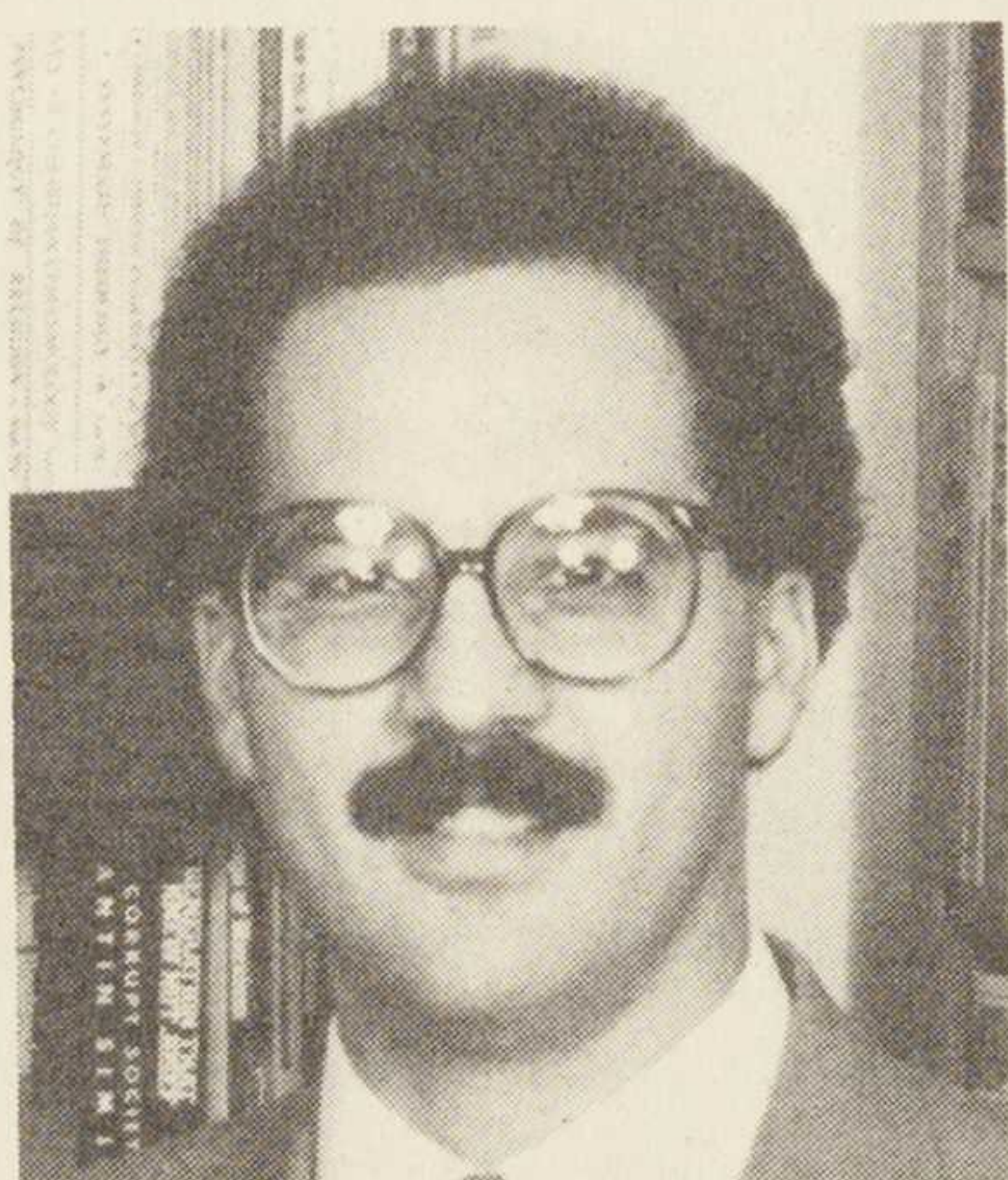


R.J. RUSHDOONY

President of the Chalcedon Foundation, Rev. Rushdoony is one of America's foremost theologians. He is the author of more than 30 books on philosophy, theology, world and American history, including *Revolt Against Maturity*, *The Messianic Character of American Education*, *The Philosophy of the Christian Curriculum*, and his most comprehensive work, the 2 volume *Institutes of Biblical Law*. He is frequently called to give expert testimony in court cases involving Christian schools & activities. Through his work and writings he has become the pre-eminent spokesman for Christian Reconstruction today, revitalizing Christian families and churches throughout the world and providing the theological underpinnings for a redirection of Western Civilization based on Biblical principles.

GARY DeMAR

President of American Vision foundation in Atlanta, Mr. DeMar is the author of five books, among them the widely used three volume *God & Government* series, which are rapidly becoming for all ages the standard textbooks for Christian civil government. He graduated from Reformed Theological Seminary in 1979 with a Master of Divinity degree. Mr. DeMar serves as the General Editor of the Biblical World View Library and *The Biblical World View*, American Vision's monthly magazine. He is a frequent and popular speaker on economics, law, education, America's Christian heritage, Christian activism, abortion, and politics.

A thrice-weekly columnist for the *Washington Times*, Mr. Lofton is a contributing editor at the *Conservative Digest*. For more than 2 years he broadcast a six-times/-weekly commentary on the Mutual Radio network.
