

If our text means anything; it reveals his Work, Works manifest His Person, "...God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself..." 2 Cor. 5:19.

What distorted views men have of Jesus the Christ! 'They' are authors of confusion!

False interpretations of the doctrine of the Person of Christ is the curse of the false prophet, the error of the uninstructed scribe.

Not to tell, explain, expound who Jesus IS; is the capital crime of the modern pulpit!

Human attempts to explain Christ, dishoner Him! Scatter the sheep of His pasture. Expose our human ignorance...

Faith in Christ involves the Godhead of Christ...This means that to be 'in Christ' is to be in God.

Everybody ought to know who Jesus is...

Four factors bring us understanding of Christ's Person.

1. HE WAS HUMAN, so that everything that can be predicated of man as man---NOT of Adam-man as fallen--BUT of the last Adam. "Behold the man." Pilate spoke more than he knew!
2. HE WAS GOD, so that everything that can be predicated of God can be predicated of Him. "God was manifest in the flesh." PAUL
3. HE WAS SON OF GOD, SON OF MAN, united in one person. Jesus Christ was NOT a double personality, but was one self. Theanthropos!
4. THE TWO NATURES IN THE ONE PERSON OF CHRIST WERE INSEPARABLY UNITED, yet were not mingled, or confounded. Christ; the burning bush!

It is around these points all CHRISTOLOGICAL CONTROVERSIES have swirled.

Mr. Preacher...What does it mean to "PREACH CHRIST?"

It may be safely said, there is no such thing as preaching Christ unless it is the preaching of ONE WHO LIVES IN RESURRECTION POWER!

The Apostles preached: "Jesus and the resurrection."

To 'preach Christ' means to preach that Person as present in the sovereignty of His resurrection. The Apostolic preaching rested here...His exaltation in power and therefore His perpetual presence..

The historical Jesus is indispensable: BUT if we are to have a genuine Apostolic understanding, the historical must become present...How can we know in preaching THE KINGDOM OF GOD we are 'preaching Christ'? The answer is clear---THE KINGDOM OF GOD comes only in and through Him, and that its character is ultimately determined by that fact.

We CANNOT...Bring in The Kingdom...Amen "Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear." ACTS 2:33
