WHY

To create deeper, more diverse contacts between citizens of the United States and the Soviet Union.

WHO

More than 800 Soviet citizens, many of them members of the thousands of "informal" voluntary organizations which have blossomed under glasnost—teachers, factory workers, doctors, artists, scientists, journalists and others who have come together, without official sponsorship, to pursue environmental, historical, national, religious, charitable or other objectives. Others in the *Database* are individual Soviet citizens who would like an opportunity to meet with visiting Americans, perhaps for no other reason than to engage in conversation and practice their English.

WHAT

For each contact the *Database* includes the following information, when available:

- Phone numbers and addresses
- English-speaking ability
- Organizational affiliation and occupation
- Brief background information

WHERE

With entries from Murmansk to Tbilisi and from Kiev to Khabarovsk, the *Database* includes representatives of all major Soviet nationalities. Organized by city and republic, it can be customized to suit a specific itinerary or interest.
