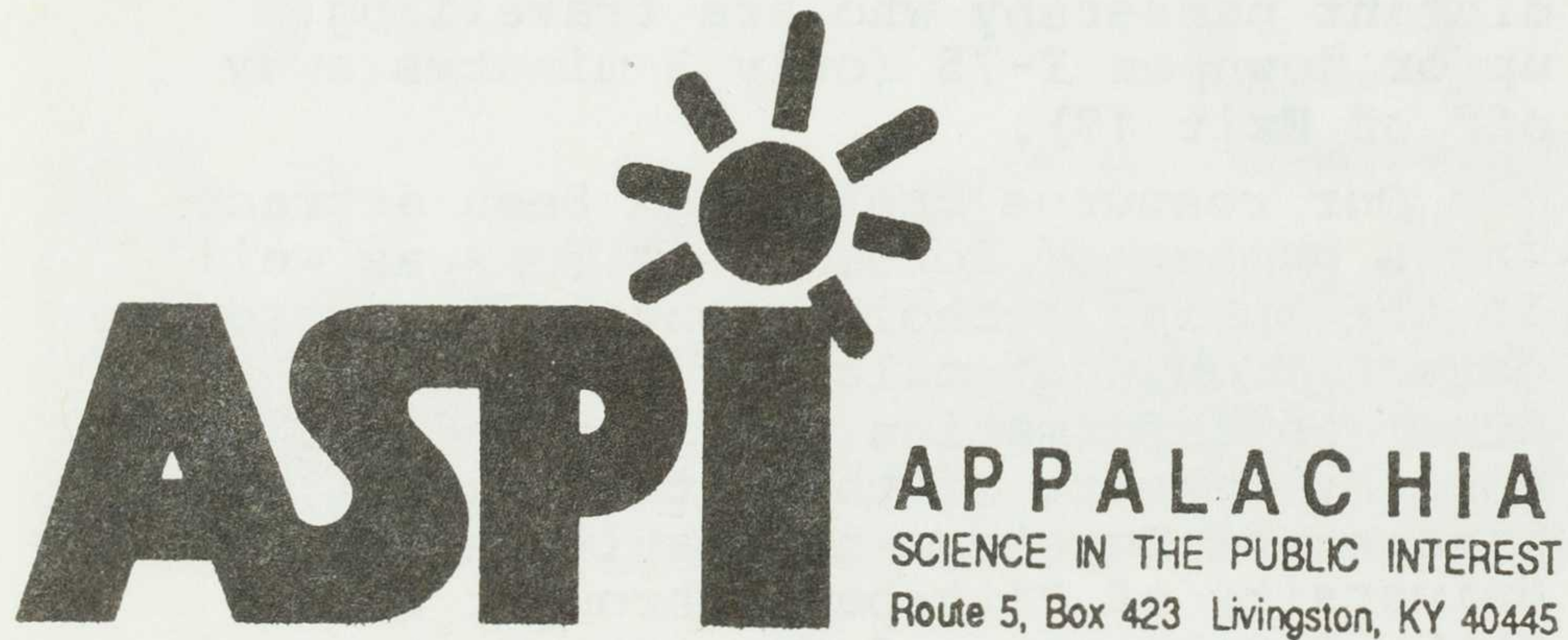


WISH LIST
