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## SUMMARY

Of the over 500 animal studies on cocaine use researched at the time of this writing, 380 are analyzed in this report. Significantly, most of the \$100 million that bankrolled these projects came from the American taxpayer. In addition to the pain, suffering and death inflicted on over 17,000 of these animals, presumptive evidence of unnecessary duplication was discovered in several areas of this work. This report concludes that these projects have not resulted in any significant advances in the prevention and treatment of cocaine abuse. On the other hand, clinical histories appear to show that psychotherapy is adequate treatment for most cocaine abusers. It is clear that animal studies have failed to meet the challenge of this current epidemic of drug use.
