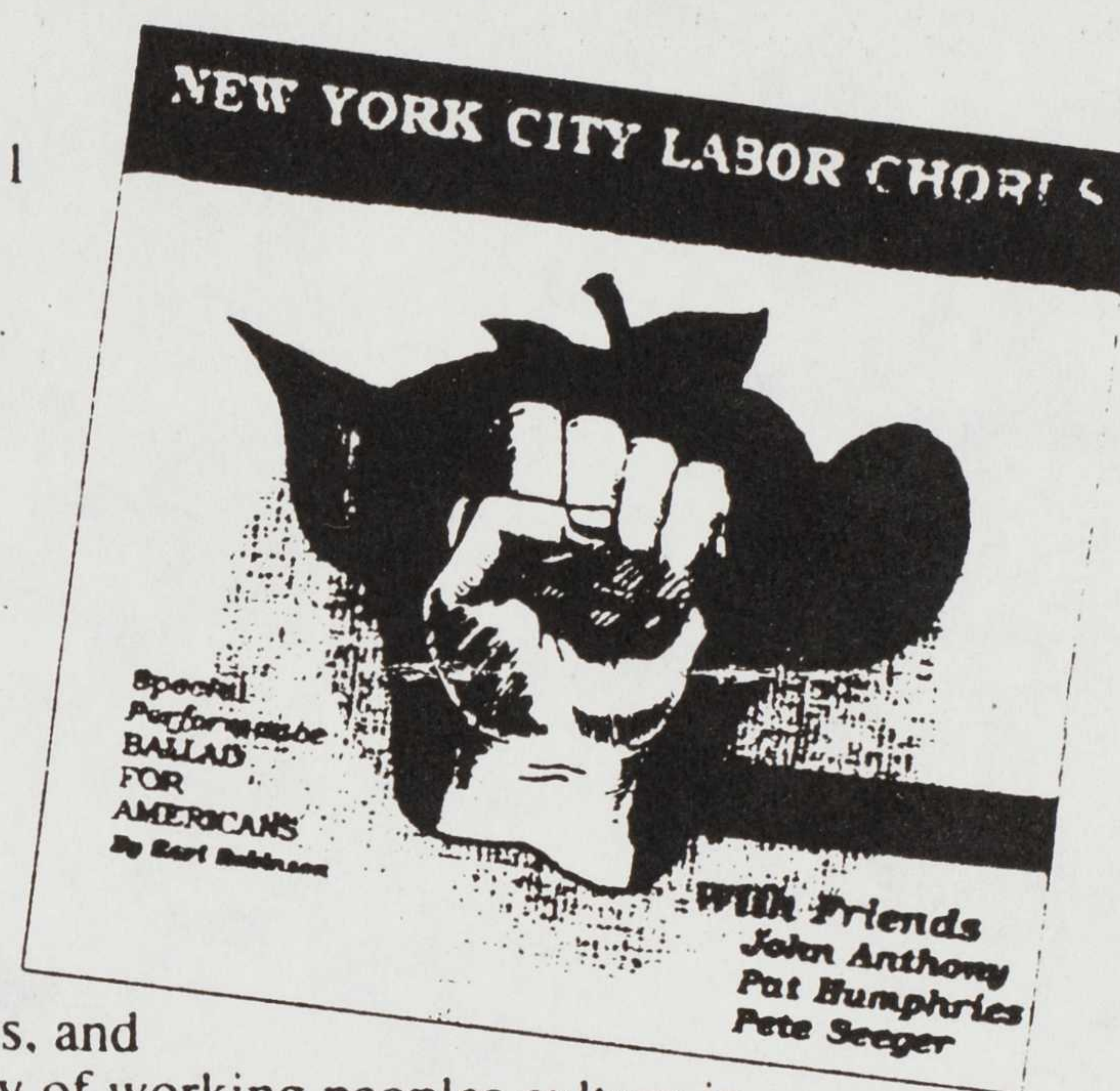


New York City Labor Chorus

Tape Cassette and Compact Disc

This is the first recording of the four year old New York City Labor Chorus, which made its debut performance at the 1991 Bread & Roses Cultural Conference at 1199 Headquarters in NYC. Comprised of over 60 members from a dozen NYC unions, the Chorus has since made its mark on the labor scene, performing at Avery Fischer Hall, Town Hall, Madison Square Garden, Hunter College and most recently at the June 8, 1994 National Health Care Rally in Washington D.C. The New York City Labor Chorus has energized and brought a greater sense of solidarity to the labor movement.

This tape was made at the First Annual New York City Labor Chorus Benefit Concert June 19, 1993 at the Martin Luther King Jr. High School in Manhattan. Under the leadership of chorus director Geoffrey Fairweather, this multi-ethnic, multi-generational chorus, - the only one of its kind in the country-, performs not only songs of labor struggles, union songs, and songs of social protest, but also songs reflecting the rich diversity of working peoples culture in the chorus - songs in gospel, jazz, classical and folk tradition.
