Meet AFA's Founder

Don Wildmon is an ordained Methodist minister, having earned his MDiv. from Emory College in 1965. After serving in the U.S. Army's Special Services he pastored churches from 1965 until he founded National Federation for Decency in 1977. NFD became American Family Association in 1988.

Since 1977, Don has devoted his full time to leading this organization. In addition, he serves as executive director of Christian Leaders for Responsible Television (CLear-TV).

Don and his wife Lynda have four children. He knows first-hand the battle parents face today teaching their families traditional moral values. Don tells in his own words how NFD (now AFA) was founded:

"One evening in 1977 I sat down with my family to watch TV. On one channel was adultery, on another cursing, on another a man beating another over the head with a hammer. I asked the children to turn off the TV. I sat there, got angry, and said, 'They're going to bring this into my home, and I'm going to do all I can to change it.'

"I brooded for a while and then came up with a plan for our church to turn off the TV for a week. I sent out a press release and the national media picked up on it.

"Through that 'Turn Off The TV Week' I learned that there were literally millions of other people around the country who felt the same way I did. That was the beginning of the American Family Association".
