✓ ALLIED ORGANIZATIONS FOR FREEDOM

By-Laws

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this organization shall be ALLIED ORGANIZATIONS (GROUPS?) FOR FREEDOM.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

The organization has the sole purpose of facilitating cooperative effort among the groups which compose its membership.

ARTICLE ~~III~~ IV

Membership (see p. 3 for article IV)

Various categories of membership may be created by the Planning Council as the occasion arises, but regular membership shall be open only to non-profit voluntary groups whose agendas include a concern for the survival of freedom, primarily but not exclusively in the United States, and who espouse neither domestic violence nor bigotry in any form.

ARTICLE IV

Dues

Membership groups may be assessed dues to cover operating expenses which are approved by the Planning Council, and shall be the same for all groups holding regular membership. Dues shall be payable / within 30 days from the beginning of the fiscal year, July 1 to June 30. If receipts from any source exceed \$_____ the financial officer responsible for handling the funds shall be bonded.

ARTICLE V III

Organizational Structure - The Planning Council

Each member organization shall be entitled to one representative on the Planning Council. The Planning Council shall review suggestions submitted by member groups o
