

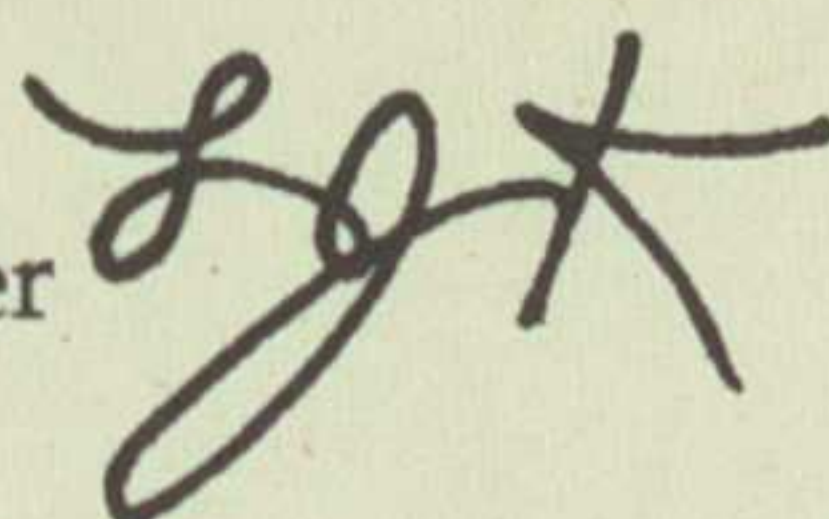

Special Emergency Notice

Due to severe public funding cuts for AIDS work from all levels of government, we have established a \$5.2 million budget for the fiscal year that begins on July 1, 1990.

- This is \$600,000 less than AIDS ACTION'S current budget.
- This is \$1 million less that we need simply to maintain today's level of service next year.

AIDS ACTION'S caseload -- now at 1,000+ families -- has grown by 30% this year. Yet there have been cuts rather than growth in monies allocated to AIDS by public funding sources.

Your individual support makes an enormous difference:

- * Fully two-thirds of our funding comes from the private sector.
- * Every dollar we invest in staff is matched by two dollars in donated services from our 1,500+ volunteers.
