

wide distribution activities of the UNICEF program, all the representatives of the UN participate.

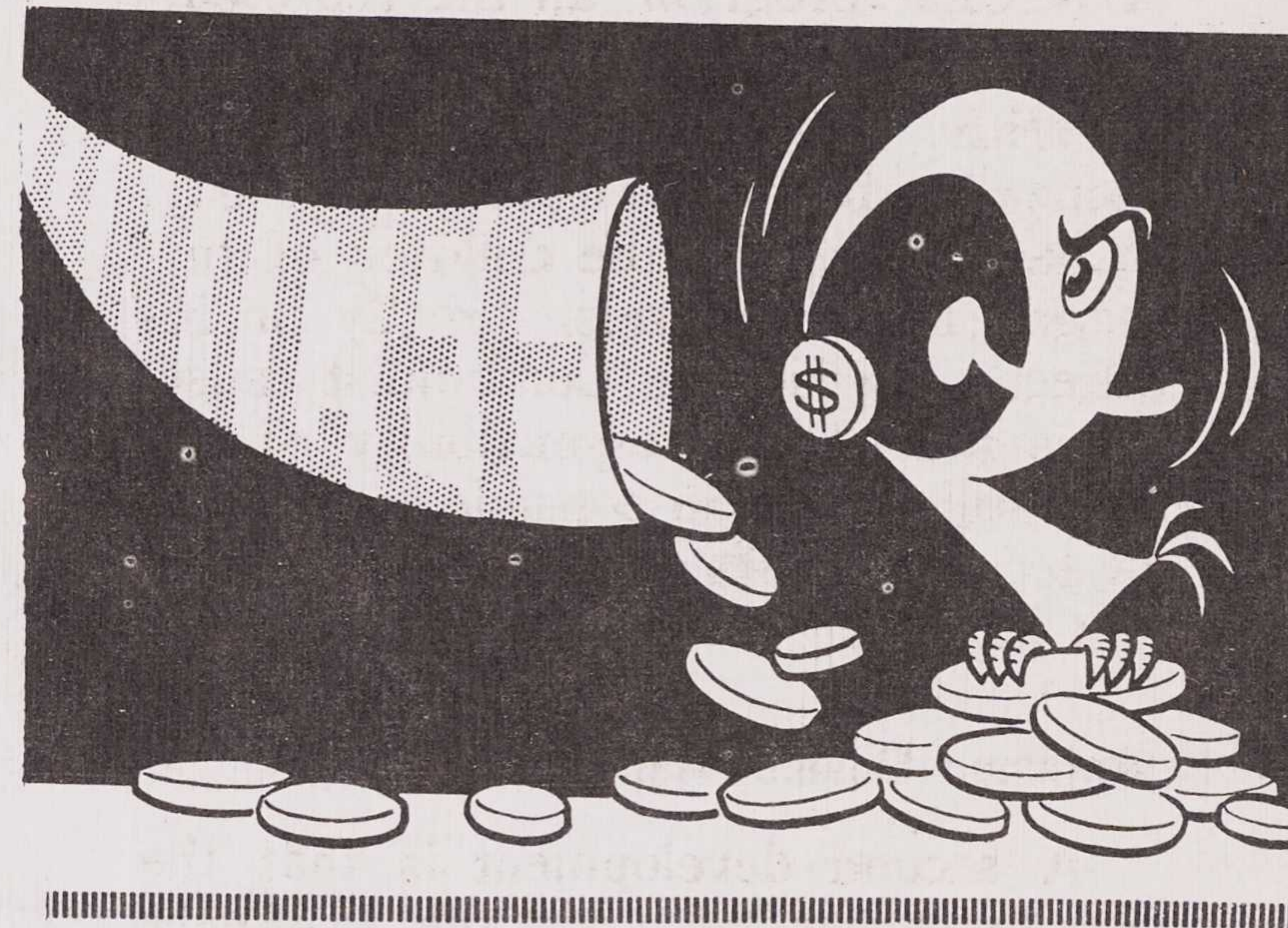

Senator Dirksen, in order to get his amendment on prayer before the Senate, offered it in conjunction with a resolution to establish UNICEF Day as a national and Government-approved day. When the prayer amendment was defeated, Senator Joseph D. Tydings of Maryland then received the privilege of the Senate to introduce the resolution, which was then passed to be sent on to the President for his approval.

Here again the American people must face the confusion that abounds in Washington, D. C., in relationship to the Communist menace. The conclusion of the editorial from the Richmond, Va., paper is correct, "The
