Many thanks for your letter of July 29th, and I hope you will excuse the delay in answering. I have just returned from vacation and was away when your letter arrived.

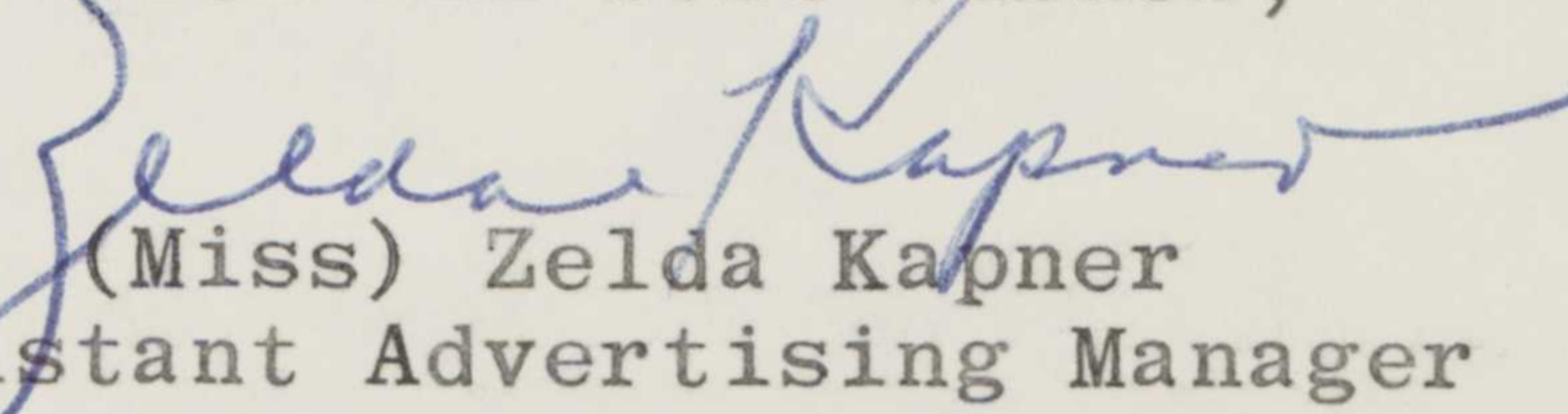
