

A brief description:

"SURVIVAL...OR SUICIDE" is a 24-minute, 16mm, color documentary film dealing with the strategic military forces of the U.S. and the U.S.S.R. Depiction of two actual nuclear alerts, plus an authentic war-game scenario of how a local uprising in Eastern Europe could develop and involve the superpowers, serve to dramatize the risks inherent in a continued arms race. The film culminates with a presentation of the human aspects of a nuclear exchange, the SALT process at work, a sequence on U.S. verification capabilities, and the role of the U.S. Senate concerning ratification of any strategic arms limitation treaty.
