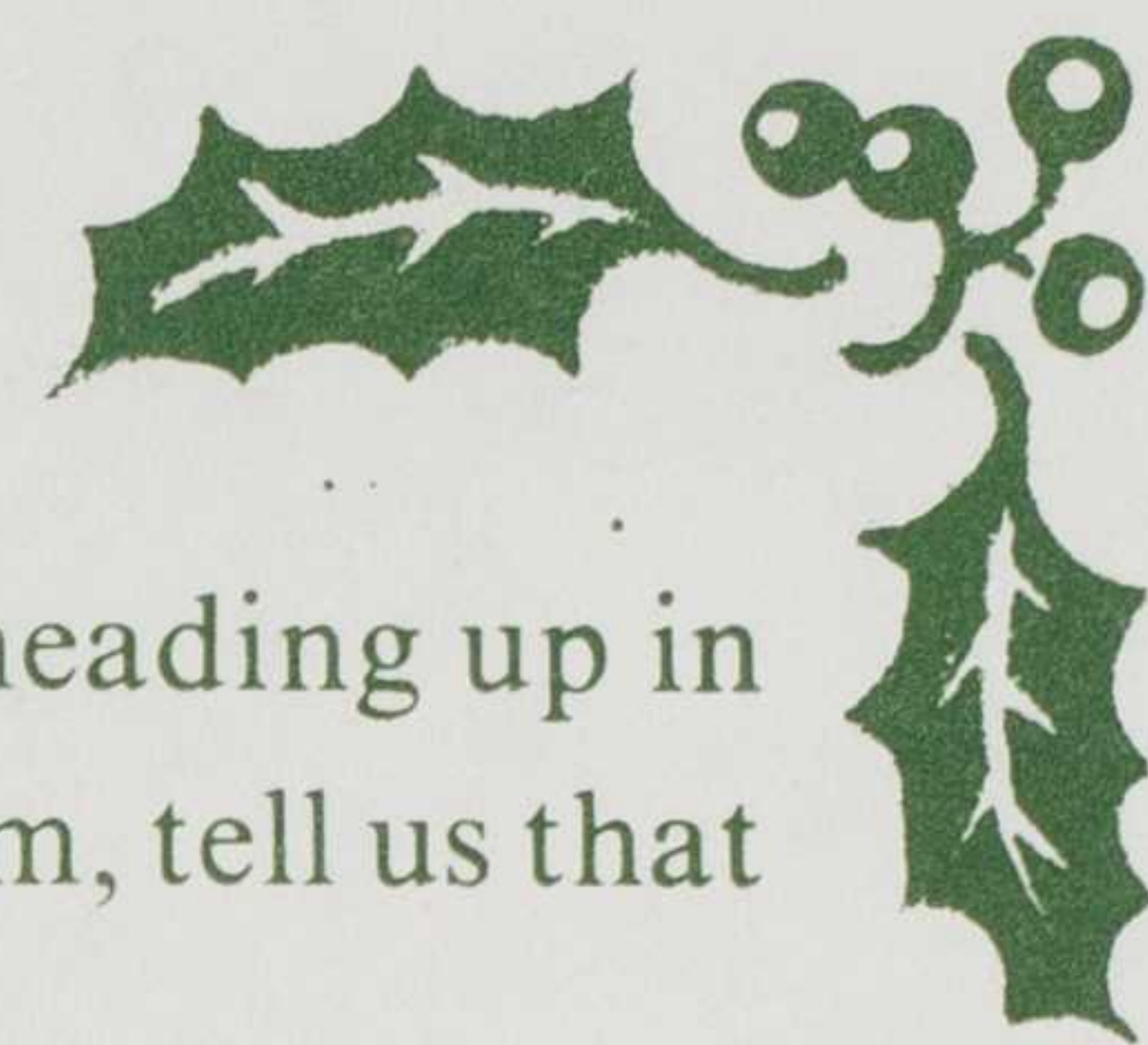




To Our Entire Family, Friends and Givers

At last, at last, after all that they have done to stop us and kill our ministry and the six years we fought over WXUR and lost, now we can go places. It really is magnificent. I am coming to you with the greatest Christmas appeal I have ever made. This opens doors. I have reached thousands of people who have never heard McIntire. There are five million dishes which can pick up my program and I can be seen. The word has to get around.

The only thing that can stop me is the lack of money, but with the money, in the next three years — that is the contract — we could be used really to shake this nation.

At last we can get around this liberal media that has done so much to condition our country.

Maybe you have heard that the National Council of Churches has had a disaster. They cannot get the money to keep themselves. The General Board met in New York, November 1-4, and they admitted that they could not go on the way they were. They have appointed a 15-man committee to bring in a structural organization which will include the Roman Catholics and the evangelicals.

This debacle is a direct result of what we and other Fundamentalists have been doing to convince the country that the NCC is not Christian. They have another religion which their pluralism and dialoguing have produced. They live by consensus, not by the revelation of the Book of Genesis to Revelation.

Mrs. McIntire and I saw it on the 6 p.m. news. He said we should assure our young men that if they ever were sent to war again, they would be permitted to win.
