Could you understand the mental processes of a man who would say, "That liquor dealer is all right. He is sending out the gospel so he surely must be a man of God"?

The man's objective was to sell liquor and he played "Little Lord Jesus" to carry it through. If he did any good by playing "Little Lord Jesus" he neutralized it by "putting an enemy" in his neighbor's "mouth to steal away his brains".

Even if the man's purpose had not been to sell whiskey; if he had been sincerely attempting to bring glory to God and his reason for playing "Little Lord Jesus" had been to evangelize his city it still would have seemed incongruous, inappropriate, and wrong to associate "Little Lord Jesus" with a Liquor Store. And if somebody in the store buying whiskey had fallen under conviction and got converted and thrown away his liquor, such a method of evangelism would have been wrong.
