Attached is a letter dated August 8 from MOINHO, Salvador, which encloses copies of a letter dated August 27, 1962, and a bill **Ilmo. Sr.** for the same date for Cr\$1,422,600, as well as a copy of a **Almir F. Protásio** of 3, 1963. The bill for Cr\$1,422,600, according to **Moinho Salvador**, pertains to 598 bags which were required in addition **Rua Estado de Israel** ordered by USAID for a shipment of corn aboard **Nesta**.

According to a letter dated December 31, 1962, from Mr. George M. **Prezado Sr. Protásio:** **Moinho**, payment for the 22,000 bags was made by check #19445 dated August 14, 1962, in the amount of Cr\$1,110,000.

Attached is a letter dated August 8 from MOINHO, Salvador, which encloses copies of a letter dated August 20, 1962, and a bill N^o 5114 of the same date for Cr\$49,442,60; as well as a copy of a letter dated January 3, 1963. The bill for Cr\$49,492,60, according to this correspondence, pertains to 598 bags which were required in addition to the 22,000 bags ordered by USAID for a shipment of corn aboard the "MORMACTIDE".

According to a letter dated December 27, 1962, from Mr. George D. Hawbaker to Vice Consul Matthews, payment for the 22,000 bags was made by check N^o 19445 dated August 10, 1962, in the amount of Cr\$1,118,960,00.

The Consulate's files do not indicate what action has been taken on the bill for the additional 598 bags for which MOINHO Salvador claims they have not been paid. Vice Consul Matthews, who might have information about this subject, is on leave.

The Consulate would appreciate receiving information as to the reply it should make to the MOINHO Salvador in regard to payment for the 598 bags.



