Second, sign and mail the three postcards addressed to three leading sponsors of Bochco's L.A. LAW.

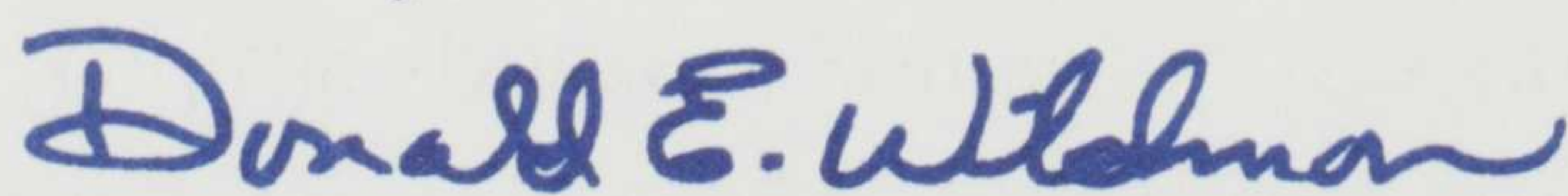
There is a third action I hope you will choose to take.
