

to Russian Communism, with its centralized autocracy, state monopolies, and agricultural collectives. Chinese culture exalts the individual; Communism degrades him. Chinese individualism is a temporary weakness against the impact of organized aggression; an ultimate source of strength in its limitless constancy.

Family Loyalty and Discipline - The pride, respect, discipline, and loyalty of the Chinese family is unequalled by any other human group. Ancestor worship was common in China only recently; the family elder is still respected, obeyed, and honored as nowhere else in the world. These virtues are in direct opposition to Russian Communism, which encourages and officially rewards family disloyalty and ridicules the authority and prestige of the family elders.

Respect for Knowledge and Education - The Chinese honor the teacher and student as do no other people. The Chinese philosophers taught a way of life based on truth, tolerance, and individual humility. In China the order of prestige for professions is; first, the teacher; second, the merchant; third, the farmer; and last, the man in uniform, soldier or official. Russian Communism reverses the order; first, the man in uniform, soldier or official; second, the laborer and farmer; third, the merchant; and last, the seeker for the truth, the teacher.

Courage - Courage is a most common human possession, otherwise the massive odds in favor of established oppression would overawe us all and freedom would have long since disappeared from the earth. We all have it, the Chinese no less than the most arrogant Occidental. Courage inflamed by national pride and devotion, spurred by foreign threats inspires a heroism and resolution which cannot be defeated, it can only be destroyed. Those who demand full scale war against the Chinese at this time to whitewash our official stupidity and support European Colonialism had better well remember how often history has verified this statement. The Communist masters of China, stooges of the Kremlin, cannot be dislodged by pouring death and destruction on the humble Chinese people. Such action will only seat them more firmly in the saddle. The resentment and agony of the Chinese people will merge their objectives with those of Communist Russia, i.e., the destruction of America. The solution is the neutralization of Communist Russia.

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
