Dear Chief Minister,

It may be recalled that the National Common Minimum Programme provides that "the Right to Information (RTI) Act will be made more progressive, participatory and meaningful". The Union Government are, accordingly, engaged in finalizing the RTI Bill which envisages a State legislation in regard to Right to Information to co-exist alongwith the proposed Central legislation.

2. In the circumstances and in order to reinforce transparency, accountability and efficiency in governance, you may like to initiate the process of bringing in a State legislation in respect of Right to Information. A copy of the draft RTI Bill (forwarded by the National Advisory Council to the Government of India) is attached herewith. This could be modified suitably to formulate a State Bill on Right to Information.
